Principal Guidelines for Decision Support

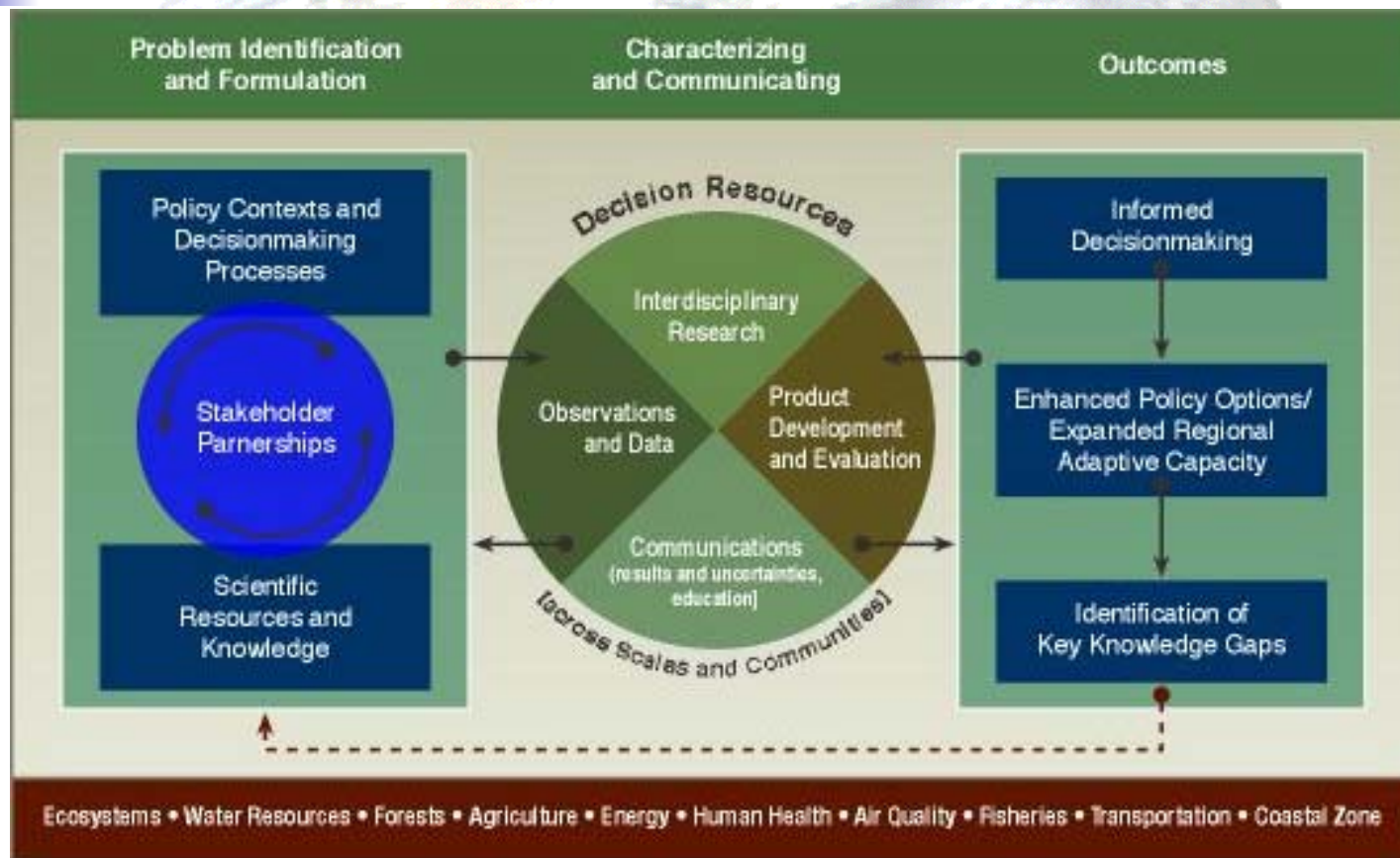
- Analyses structured around specific questions
- Early and continuing involvement of stakeholders
- Explicit treatment of uncertainties
- Transparent public review of analysis questions, methods, and draft results
- Evaluation of ongoing CCSP analyses and build on lessons learned



Decision Support Goals

- Prepare scientific syntheses and assessments to support informed discussion of climate variability and change issues by decision-makers, stakeholders, the media, and the general public
- Develop resources to support adaptive management and planning for responding to climate variability and climate change, and transition these resources from research to operational application
- Develop and evaluate methods (scenario evaluations, integrated analyses, and alternative analytical approaches) to support climate change policymaking and demonstrate these methods with case studies

Challenge: Decision Support Framework



Revisions in Response to NRC and Public Comments

- Completely revised chapter on decision support resources
- Articulation of guiding principals for decision support
- Identification of decision-types to be supported
- Specific goals, objectives, and approaches
- Explicit statement of evaluation of uncertainty
- Use of illustrative examples
- New chapter on modeling strategy (research, applied climate modeling, impacts)
- Enhanced chapter on observing systems



Decision Support Implementation

- Decision support management structure
 - Within overall CCSP management
 - Specific delineated responsibilities (IWGCCST, Interagency Working Group, CCSPPO)
- Guidelines for producing syntheses and assessment reports
- Workshop in planning stages
