## **Motivations for CPATH**

- Fluctuating enrollments in academic programs
- Multidisciplinary nature of field
- Industry and workforce needs
- Need for more innovation in light of a global economy
- Multiple pathways to more effective education



## Focus of CPATH

- Revitalize undergrad computing education in the US
- Effect fundamental change
- Engage CS leaders broadly
- Promote leadership, partnerships, community building, institutional transformation
- Contribute to national competitiveness



# Types of Activities Funded by CPATH

Community Building (CB)	<ul> <li>Bring stakeholders together to transform undergraduate computing education</li> <li>Encourage strategies at regional and/or national levels and across all institution types</li> <li>Plan activities for transformation implementations and community building</li> </ul>
CISE Distinguished Education Fellows (CDEF)	<ul> <li>Recognized leader</li> <li>Innovative action project</li> <li>Community building</li> <li>Advocacy for undergraduate computing education</li> <li>Prestige of CDEF award and designation within institution and departments</li> </ul>
Institutional Transformation (T)	<ul> <li>Adopt/replicate innovative approaches now underway across institutions with community building</li> <li>Evaluate particular approach across multiple institutions</li> <li>Blur traditional boundaries in academic institutions</li> <li>Involve a focus broader than curriculum building</li> <li>Develop industry and international partnerships</li> </ul>
Evaluation, Adoption, and Extension (EAE)	<ul> <li>Adopt promising models now underway</li> <li>Evaluate impact of new models underway</li> <li>Expand scope of ongoing efforts</li> <li>Engage other institutions in implementing institution model</li> <li>Disseminate lessons learned</li> </ul>



## **CPATH Budget/Awards**

- Standard Grant or Continuing Grant
- Estimated Number of Awards:

18 to 30 total.

- 15 to 25 Community Building (CB) awards (several of which may be focused at the national level),
- 1 or 2 Evaluation, Adoption and Extension (EAE) awards,
- 1 or 2 Transformation (T) awards, and
- 1 to 3 CISE Distinguished Education Fellow (CDEF) awards.
- Anticipated Funding Amount:

\$6,000,000 in FY 2007.

- **CB** projects are likely to be funded from levels of \$50,000 to a maximum of \$500,000 total for durations up to three years.
- **EAE** projects will be funded at levels up to \$900,000 total for durations of up to three years.
- **T** projects will be funded at levels up to \$1,500,000 total for a maximum duration of five years.
- **CDEF** projects will be supported at levels up to \$250,000 total for a maximum duration of two years, with potential for renewal for a third year.



## **CPATH Focus This Year**

- Community building and CDEF projects
- Planning and pilot projects -- few full scale implementations
- Seed many promising ideas with competition in the future for full implementation
