The mission of the Records Division is to maintain and provide timely access to paper and electronic records and information to authorized parties within the immigration benefit and enforcement communities.


The Records Division is the official custodian of and responsible for more than 110 million immigrant records. More than half of these are immigrant alien files (A-Files) and the other records are of a historic nature detailing the entry and exit of immigrants dating back to the late 19th

century. In the course of normal business operations, USCIS annually creates approximately one million new A-files.

The Records Division was restructured in January 2007 to realign with the mission and goals of USCIS and to better facilitate the records management functions within the organization. The Records Division is comprised of six branches. Each of the branches has flourished under the new realigned structure.
