DECISION OF THE ADJUDICATING OFFICIAL

The Executive Office for Immigration Review issued an order September 9, 2004 suspending the respondent from practice before the Board, the Immigration Courts, and the DHS. See 8 C.F.R. 1003.103(a), 1292.3(c).

A request for a hearing was filed by the respondent. At a hearing held January 25, 2005, the respondent withdrew his request for a hearing, and accepts the order of suspension. The respondent may apply for reinstatement, when he again is a member in good standing of any bar within the United States.


Accordingly the following order will be entered:
