The Alaska section consists of 4 cargo aircraft. The Domestic Services section consists of 37 aircraft. The Short-Range International section consists of 13 cargo and 270 passenger aircraft. The Aeromedical Evacuation segment consists of 50 aircraft. The Long-Range International section consists of 300 cargo and 690 passenger aircraft. Total CRAF aircraft is 1,364.

The above allocations are authorized in conformance with the Defense Production Act of 1950 (DPA), as amended (50 U.S.C., App. 2061, <u>et seq</u>.)
