SUBJECT: May 2007 Civil Reserve Air Fleet (CRAF) Allocation

The April 2007 CRAF allocation issued May 8, 2007 is hereby amended. The distribution reflected in this letter, covering May 2007, brings the CRAF allocations up-to-date. The Alaska section consists of 4 cargo aircraft. The Domestic Services section consists of 37 aircraft. The Short-Range International section consists of 13 cargo and 270 passenger aircraft. The Aeromedical Evacuation segment consists of 50 aircraft. The Long-Range International section consists of 300 cargo and 690 passenger aircraft. Total CRAF aircraft is 1,364.
