In follow up to the December 21, 2005, distribution of the Draft 2 ENERGY STAR specification (Version 1.0) for Imaging Equipment products, please find attached supporting rationale and data for the Typical Electricity Consumption (TEC) Eligibility Criteria as provided in Section 3.A. of the specification.

Please note that the dataset has been masked with regard to identifying information, such as manufacturer, brand name, and model number. Figures corresponding to the four TEC criteria tables included in the Draft 2 specification are provided in the rationale document to help illustrate the methodology behind the development of these criteria.
