







The English Language Institute (ELI)

- Own entity on campus; Accredited by the Commission on English Language Program Accreditation (CEA)
- Issue their own I-20 for F Visa Status
- Three ways to enter the University via ELI
 - 1. ELI only non-credit English Language Training only
 - Bridge Course Academic preparation course for nonnative students; upon reaching language requirements (TOEFL min.500) transfer to the University
 - 3. Conditional Admission TOEFL min. 450; upon reaching language requirement admittance to University courses
