### *Cooperative efforts to restore native ecosystems*

The Conservation Partnerships Program (CPP) can provide cost-share funds, as well as information on habitat restoration techniques, native species, Safe Harbor Agreements, additional funding sources, required permits, and potential vendors of restoration services. Additionally, the CPP seeks to provide a connection between habitat restoration projects and potential non-USFWS funding sources.



**The Conservation Partnerships Program (CPP) is a collection of voluntary habitat restoration programs with the goal of restoring native Pacific Island ecosystems through collaborative projects.**
