**\$ 10,000 Reward Offered For Stolen Government Laptop**

The Office of Inspector General (OIG) of the U.S. Department of Transportation today announced it is offering a reward of up to \$10, 000 for any information leading to the recovery of a laptop computer that was reported stolen on July 27 in the Miami, FL, area.
