D.C. Booth National Historic Fish Hatchery

D.C. Booth National Historic Fish Hatchery/South Dakota




Figure 12. DC Booth National Fish Hatchery National Register Site

D.C. Booth Historic National Fish Hatchery is listed on the National Register of Historic Places (figure 12). The hatchery is one of the oldest in the county and is the home of the National Fisheries Archives facility, Von Bayer Museum of Fish Culture, and Fish Culture Hall of Fame -- all located in rehabilitated historical structures being used for these new purposes.

The buildings and fisheries archives have spurred educational interest and partnership, with support provided by Booth Society, Inc., City of Spearfish, American Fisheries Society-Fish Culture Section, and the South Dakota Department of Game, Fish, and Parks. The hatchery has received funding from a Save America's Treasures grant.
