2006 American Community Survey: Overview of Data Release

The American Community Survey (ACS) is a nationwide survey that provides annually updated, detailed socioeconomic, housing, and demographic information for communities across the United States and Puerto Rico. This year's data release marks the first time that group quarters (such as prisons, college dorms, military barracks and nursing homes) are included in the data products.

The ACS will release estimates for areas with a population of 65,000 or more. Data from the Puerto Rico Community Survey will be released concurrently.

By its sample design, the ACS accumulates independent monthly sample data throughout the calendar year. This allows for the release of estimates for smaller geographic areas once enough sample data has been accumulated.

This chart explains the ACS release strategy, as it will unfold over the coming years.
