<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> In addition to the FY 2003, \$2.88 billion in injunctive relief, the Virginia Electric and Power Company (VEPCO) case produced \$1.2 billion in injunctive relief. This case will result in reductions of 237,000 tons of sulfur dioxide (SO2) and nitrogen oxides (NOx) emissions. In addition to providing for major pollution reductions, VEPCO agreed to pay a \$5.3 million civil penalty and spend at least \$13.9 million, which is not included in the FY 2003 totals for projects in each of the five states that participated in the settlement to offset the impact of past emissions. EPA lodged this case on April 21, 2003; however the Court entered the case on October 3, 2003.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> Includes \$125 million for an innovative settlement with ASARCO that was achieved in FY 2003 under the authority of the Federal Debt Collection Procedures Act and the Federal Priorities Act. This settlement provides funds to partially fulfill ASARCO's obligations under numerous prior federal and state consent decrees and administrative orders for work at CERCLA and non-CERCLA sites, work conducted for or by other Federal agencies, and work at sites where states are conducting or overseeing the work.
