

2007 ENERGY STAR® Awards

General Instructions

Each year, the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the US Department of Energy (DOE) honor organizations that have made outstanding contributions to protecting the environment through superior energy efficiency. All organizations participating in ENERGY STAR are encouraged to apply for a 2007 ENERGY STAR Award. Organizations may apply for more than one award if they meet the eligibility requirements. In such cases, a complete award application package must be submitted for each award.

To be considered, an organization must meet the specific eligibility requirements in the award application and submit a complete application package by **December 15, 2006**. Winners will be recognized at the ENERGY STAR Awards Ceremony on March 21, 2007 in Washington, DC.

Application Instructions

- Review eligibility for the award to which you are applying and respond to all award criteria
 specified in the application that you are completing. Do not exceed the page limitation
 specified in the award application, as additional pages will not be considered. (Samples and
 collateral materials are not included in the page limit.)
- Summary of Accomplishments Please provide a brief overview (no more than 300 words) of your organization and the accomplishments upon which you are applying for this ENERGY STAR award. In the event that you are chosen to receive an award, this text will be the basis used in preparing a summary of your organization's achievements.
- Where applicable, **quantify your activities and the results** (e.g., percent improvement, number of marketing pieces produced, number of people reached), and enclose documentation that supports claims made (e.g., photos of promotional materials, samples of advertisements with the ENERGY STAR mark, copies of training materials used, etc.).
- Provide specific information about your efforts, accomplishments and materials
 developed in 2006 only. While planned activities for 2007 or beyond are of interest to
 EPA and DOE, they should not be the focus of the award application.
- Organization Logo Please provide electronic copies of both color and a black-and-white versions of your logo in **EPS format** that will allow for a printable resolution of 300 dpi at a size of 4 inches. In the event that your organization is chosen for an award, this logo will be used in the awards ceremony materials.

Application Submissions

- For each award to which you are applying, provide:
 - one complete hard copy of your entire application package, including the General Information form, responses to awards criteria, and any samples, collateral, and supplemental materials, AND
 - one electronic copy (in Word or WordPerfect) of your completed application via e-mail to the ENERGY STAR Awards Coordinator, Kate Lewis, at: lewis.kate@epa.gov.
 Please do not forward supplemental materials via e-mail.
- All hard copy and electronic applications must be date marked/postmarked no later than
 December 15, 2006. EPA and DOE will not accept any applications or materials date
 marked/postmarked after this date. Due to the volume of material that will be received, EPA
 and DOE will not be able to return any materials or promotional pieces.
- Send completed applications to the appropriate address below. It is highly recommended
 that overnight or two day delivery be used to avoid potential delays and damage due
 to enhanced security screening of standard mail to government facilities. Do NOT fax
 application packages or sample materials, as they will not be accepted.

Criteria: Criteria for evaluating this award are listed below. Please note that the prerequisite for any

manufacturing award is that partners have complied with requirements outlined in the applicable ENERGY STAR Partner Commitments and Product Specification documents, including those

related to labeling, logo use and the submission of product and sales information.

Section 1 – Product Qualification Efforts

Please provide:

- Number of ENERGY STAR qualified models/units (and percentage change over previous year)
- Percentage of product line that is ENERGY STAR qualified (the percentage of models for which
 the standard version is ENERGY STAR qualified and the percentage of models that can be

- Participation in the development of data tools, such as updated Qualified Product Information (QPI) forms for the Manufacturer Search online tool.
- Number and percentage of qualified models prominently displaying the ENERGY STAR product qualification label (please submit examples of product labels and/or photographs of labeled products)
- Number and percentage of product display units labeled with the appropriate ENERGY STAR display unit label (please submit photographs of labeled displays)

Consumer Education

- Community outreach activities and messaging, ENERGY STAR-themed promotions
- Print, radio, television, direct mail advertising, brochures with ENERGY STAR messages, logo (please submit details of quality, quantity, frequency, reach)
- Public relations efforts, special events, press releases (please submit details of quality, quantity, frequency, reach)
- Inclusion of environmental messaging in any of the above activities
- Web page (please submit examples and data on reach, i.e. unique visitors and average view times for pages that include ENERGY STAR-related content)

Note: Descriptions of co-marketing activities should be accompanied with materials illustrating participation with distributors or other ENERGY STAR Partners (e.g. utilities) to educate consumers and sell more ENERGY STAR windows, doors, and skylights. It is expected that these activities will vary depending on the distribution channel and sales region. It is not expected that partners will report on leadership and/or participation in promotions in conjunction with campaigns coordinated by EPA and DOE, since this criteria element does not apply to this program area.
