# Purpose of meeting

- Goal: initiate a process that yields objective measurements of server energy use that are attached to all of the widely accepted performance benchmarks.
  - Identify the performance benchmarks most widely used by server purchasers,
  - Define a protocol for measuring energy use while the performance benchmarks are being run.
  - Do not create new performance benchmarks or favor any one benchmark over another.
