Eligibility Criteria

With regard to the eligibility specifications for central air conditioning and air source heat pump equipment, we support the energy efficiency criteria as shown in the Revised Final Draft document. The addition of the second tier criteria, to be effective January 1, 2009 for split system units is also acceptable as defined in the Revised Final Draft document.
