INTERNATIONAL SEXUAL PREDATOR LOCATED IN TEXAS

Washington, D.C. Agents assigned to the U.S. National Central Bureau (¹USNCB) of the International Criminal Police Organization (Interpol) identified and located a sexual predator in Texas. Earlier this month the USNCB's Fugitive and Terrorism and Violent Crime Division determined that Mansell DAVIES, a British national convicted of child sexual abuse, was working and residing in the Eastern District of Texas. Inquiry revealed that DAVIES had convictions in the United Kingdom for criminal indecent assault and was in violation of his UK sexual registry and notification requirements.

Due to the egregious nature of the sexual offenses committed in the United Kingdom, the USNCB requested a review of DAVIES' pending U.S. immigration dossier. This review determined that DAVIES applied for legal permanent resident status in 2003. Immigration and Customs Enforcement representatives were able to ascertain that DAVIES was immediately deportable based on evidence extracted from his immigration dossier and based on incriminating statements he made to U.S. law enforcement.

On May 09, 2008, at the request of the USNCB, Deputies from the United States Marshals Service and Special Agents from Immigration and Customs Enforcement coordinated and conducted the arrest of Mansell DAVIES. He was taken into custody without incident, is currently detained and awaits deportation to his native country of England.
