On April 26, 2006, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety issued to BP Pipeline (North America) Inc. a Final Order, which assessed a civil penalty of \$10,000 and required corrective action to comply with the Federal pipeline safety regulations.
