COMMENTS SOLICITED ON THE REVISED TRANSFER AGENT FORMS AND RULES

The Commission is soliciting comments on revisions to Form TA-1, the uniform form for registration as a transfer agent, including a new SEC Supplement to Form TA-1. The Commission is also soliciting comments on proposed Rule 17Ac2-2, which would require registered transfer agents to file an annual report of their business activities on proposed Form TA-2. Finally, the Commission proposes an amendment to Rule 17Ac2-1(c), which would extend the time period from 21 to 60 days for a transfer agent to correct information previously reported on Form TA-1 which thereafter becomes incorrect, misleading or incomplete.

COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

LIONEL CORPORATION

The Commission announced that on April 1 the bankruptcy court sustained its objection to Lionel Corporation's disclosure statement as not containing adequate information within the meaning of 11 U.S.C. 1125(a) in that it failed to contain projections of future economic performance for the reorganized company. The Commission asserted that projections are material and necessary for creditors and stockholders to evaluate the feasibility of Lionel's reorganization plan and to assess the value of the securities offered. The bankruptcy court ruled in the Commission's favor and ordered the inclusion of projections in Lionel's disclosure statement. (CR-344)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

CHARLES D'ANGELO PLEADS GUILTY

The Boston Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney for the District of Connecticut announced that criminal charges were filed against Charles D'Angelo on April 12. D'Angelo pled guilty to one count each of securities and mail fraud.

The criminal charges are related to a civil action involving D'Angelo in which the Commission sought injunctive relief [SEC v. Charles D'Angelo, USDC CT, H85-237]. In the Commission's action, D'Angelo consented, without admitting or denying the allegations, to an Order of Permanent Injunction enjoining him from future violations of the securities laws. The Commission's complaint alleged that from December 1979 through July 1984, D'Angelo, former branch manager of the Waterbury, Connecticut office of Smith Barney, Harris Upham & Co., Inc., misappropriated approximately \$800,000 from the firm's clients.

In a related administrative proceeding instituted by the Commission, D'Angelo was barred from employment in the securities industry. (U.S. v. Charles D'Angelo, USDC CT). (LR-10726)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY OF VIRGINIA

An order has been issued exempting The Life Insurance Company of Virginia, Life of Virginia Separate Account I and Life of Virginia Security Sales, Ltd. from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(35), 26(a) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 6e-3(T) to permit them to offer certain flexible premium variable life insurance contracts. GOVERNMENT INVESTORS TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 13 to request a hearing on an application by Government Investors Trust, GIT Cash Trust, GIT Tax-Free Trust, GIT Income Trust and GIT Equity Trust (Funds), and Bankers Finance Investment Management Corp. (BFIMC), on behalf of itself and of each other investment company advised by BFIMC now or in the future (collectively, Applicants). The application requests an order to permit Applicants to deposit daily cash balances which are not otherwise invested on behalf of the individual Funds into a single joint account for the purpose of entering into one or more large repurchase agreements. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE CONNECTICUT LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 13 to request a hearing on a proposal by The Connecticut Light and Power Company (CL&P), subsidiary of Northeast Utilities, to extend until December 31, 1986 the period during which CL&P may issue and sell, in one or more issues, up to 2,000,000 shares (\$50 million aggregate par value) of preferred stock with either a fixed or an adjustable dividend rate. Jurisdiction will again be reserved over the proposed issuance and sale of up to \$110 million of first and refunding mortgage bonds pending completion of the record. (Rel. 35-23665 - April 18)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (SR-NASD-85-2) which amends several sections of its Code of Procedure and By-Laws. The proposed rule change, among other things, codifies certain NASD practices relating to the expulsion and suspension of members and associated persons and also prohibits members from participating in adjudicatory proceedings in which they would have a conflict of interest.
