CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES FORMER OFFICERS OF COAL TECHNOLOGY CORPORATION

The Chicago Regional Office filed a complaint on July 31 in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Kentucky seeking injunctive and other equitable relief against three former officers and a former employee of Coal Technology Corporation (CTC), a corporation previously headquartered in Lexington, Kentucky, and now located in Downingtown, Pennsylvania. Named in the complaint were David E. Houge, Timothy J. Anderson (T. Anderson), Michael C. Cameron and Daniel L. Anderson (D. Anderson), all residents of Lexington.

The complaint alleges that the defendants, at different times from March 1981 through January 1984, violated antifraud provisions of the securities laws in the offer and sale of CTC's securities. The fraudulent conduct included the dissemination of false and misleading publicity concerning CTC's business activities and projections of revenue and profit. The complaint also alleges violations by certain of the defendants of registration and reporting provisions.

Also on July 31, orders of permanent injunction were entered, by consent, against T. Anderson and D. Anderson. Additionally, T. Anderson was ordered to file an accounting reflecting the profits and proceeds he received from certain sales of CTC's securities. (SEC v. David E. Houge, et al., EDKY, Civil Action No. 85-305). INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

FRANK RUSSELL CAPITAL COMPANY; WORLD RESOURCES FUND, LTD.

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until September 10 and 13, respectively, to request a hearing on an application by Frank Russell Capital Company and World Resources Fund, Ltd. for an order declaring that they have ceased to be investment companies. CARNEGIE-CAPPIELLO GROWTH TRUST

An order has been issued exempting Carnegie-Cappiello Growth Trust, Carnegie Government Securities Trust and Liquid Capital Income Trust, and all subsequent and similar funds managed by Carnegie Capital Management Company, from the provisions of Sections 13(a)(2), 17(d), 18(f)(1), 22(f) and 22(g) of the Investment Company Act to allow certain deferred trustees' fee arrangements. MORGAN GUARANTY TRUST COMPANY OF NEW YORK

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 10 to request a hearing on an application by Morgan Guaranty Trust Company of New York requesting an order granting an exemption from Section 17(f) to permit Morgan, as custodian or sub-custodian, to deposit securities and other assets of U.S. registered investment companies with its subsidiary banking institution in The Netherlands, which does not qualify for the exemption provided by Rule 17f-5. JOHNSTOWN AMERICAN COMPANIES

An order has been issued exempting Johnstown American Companies from all provisions of the Investment Company Act until March 31, 1986. (Rel. IC-14681 - Aug. 16)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GULF POWER COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 12 to request a hearing on a proposal by Gulf Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to issue and sell, prior to September 1, 1986, up to \$50 million aggregate principal amount of its first mortgage bonds with a maturity of not less than five nor more than 30 years. IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The American Stock Exchange, Inc. filed a proposed rule change which became effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (SR-Amex-85-25) relating to its policy regarding specialist contacts with prospect companies under Amex's equities allocation procedures, which permit a newly-listed company to participate in the choice of its specialist unit. TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

ITT FINANCIAL CORPORATION

An order has been issued under the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 on an application by ITT Financial Corporation that the trusteeship of BankAmerica Trust Company of New York (BATNY) under two indentures is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify BATNY from acting as trustee under the Shelf Indenture and the 1976 Indenture. AMERICAN EXPRESS CREDIT CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 10 to request a hearing on an application by American Express Credit Corporation under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 stating that the trusteeship of Manufacturers Hanover Trust Company (MHTC) under an indenture dated December 15, 1984, together with two supplemental indentures dated April 1, 1985 and April 15, 1985 and another indenture dated May 15, 1985, is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify MHTC from acting as trustee.
