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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### BLINDER, ROBINSON & CO., INC., MEYER BLINDER SUSPENDED; UNDERWRITINGS PRECLUDED FOR TWO YEARS

Administrative Law Judge David J. Markun issued an initial decision suspending Meyer Blinder and Blinder, Robinson & Co., Inc. from the broker-dealer business for 90 days and 45 days, respectively. For the convenience of customers, the firm will be permitted to carry out certain transactions during the suspension period. Mr. Blinder will not be required to divest himself of his ownership interest in the firm during his suspension. Additionally, for two years following the firm's suspension, both Respondents will be precluded from participating in any underwritings, directly or indirectly.

The sanctions were imposed on the bases, among others, that Respondents: had been found by the U.S. District Court for Colorado to have committed antifraud and anti-manipulation violations of the Securities and Exchange Acts in a \$25 million underwriting of American Leisure Corp. stock in 1979-80; had been enjoined by that Court from future such violations; and had sustained sanctions for other conduct in numerous state and NASD proceedings.

Judge Markun's decision is subject to review by the Commission on its own motion or on petition of a party.

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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST JAMES L. CONDRON, OTHERS

The Boston Regional Office announced that on August 26 U.S. District Judge Ellen Bree Burns, District of Connecticut, signed a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against James L. Condron, Condron Associates, Inc. and J. L. Condron & Co., Inc. enjoining them from further violations of the antifraud and credit extension provisions of the securities laws. The judgment also enjoins Condron and Condron Associates from further violations of the investment adviser registration provisions of the securities laws. Condron, Condron Associates and Condron & Co. consented to the Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations.

The February 19 complaint alleged that: Condron managed the funds and traded on behalf of five limited partnerships which had total assets of approximately \$3.4 million after syndication; Condron, Condron Associates and others falsely overstated the net asset values of the partnerships' assets in monthly and other reports to the limited partners; and Condron and Condron & Co. misappropriated approximately \$800,000 from one investor. (SEC v. James L. Condron, et al., USDC CT 1985, Civil Action No. B-85-87-EBB). (LR-10863)

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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### LIQUIDITY FUND, INC.

An order has been issued declaring that Liquidity Fund, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-14701 - Sept. 4)

An order has been issued on an application by Shearson Lehman Brothers Capital Partners - 85 (Partnership) and SLB Investment Inc., Partnership's general partner, exempting the Partnership and subsequent, similar limited partnerships from all provisions of the Investment Company Act except Sections 9, 17(a) and (d) (with certain exceptions), 30 (with exceptions) 36 and 37 and all administrative and jurisdictional provisions of the Act. **PUTNAM TAX-FREE INCOME TRUST**

An order has been issued granting Putnam Tax-Free Income Trust and Putnam Financial Services, Inc. exemption from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 11(a) and 22(c) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 22c-1 to permit the assessment, and waiver in certain cases, of a contingent deferred sales charge on redemption of shares. (Rel. IC-14703 - Sept. 4)

**KEYSTONE TAX EXEMPT TRUST**

An order has been issued granting Keystone Tax Exempt Trust exemption from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35) and 22(c) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 22c-1 to permit the assessment of a contingent deferred sales charge on redemption of shares. (Rel. IC-14703 - Sept. 4)

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## **HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

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**COLUMBUS AND SOUTHERN OHIO ELECTRIC COMPANY**

An order has been issued authorizing Columbus and Southern Ohio Electric Company (C&SOE), subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc. (AEP), to indemnify American Electric Power Service Corporation (AEPSC), AEP's subsidiary, against possible liability arising from a lawsuit filed against C&SOE and AEPSC. (Rel. 35-23819 - Sept. 5)

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**IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE**

The Midwest Stock Exchange, Inc. filed a proposed rule change which became effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) (SR-MSE-85-10) to provide that the firm who enters round lot orders through the MAX System will receive a credit of 15.0 cents per trade. (Rel. 34-22385)
