RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

AMENDMENTS TO RULE 15Bc7-1 ADOPTED

The Commission adopted amendments to Rule 15Bc7-1 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, governing the availability to the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board of copies of reports of compliance examinations of municipal securities brokers and dealers. The amendments permit examining authorities to submit certain composite information derived from compliance examinations in lieu of individual examination reports to the Commission to be made available to the Board. (Rel. 34-22601)

COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

Chairman John S.R. Shad will address the National Press Club on December 11 at a luncheon meeting, beginning at noon. Title of his remarks will be announced at a later date.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL ACTION FILED AGAINST SAVIN CORPORATION

The Commission filed a civil action on November 12 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against Savin Corporation, of Stamford, Connecticut, alleging violations of the reporting and internal controls provisions of the securities laws.

The complaint alleges that from 1981 to the present, Savin filed with the Commission annual and quarterly reports which contained financial statements that materially overstated the assets and net worth of and materially understated the losses incurred by the company. The material misstatements occurred as a result of Savin's failure to apply generally accepted accounting principles to the accounting for costs incurred in the research and development of a line of photocopying machines.

Without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations, Savin consented to a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction. (SEC v. Savin Corporation, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 85-3605) (LR-10928)

PUROFLOW, INC. ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on November 7 the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Puroflow, Inc. of Santa Monica, California. The Judgment restrained and enjoined Puroflow from failing to file timely periodic reports.

In its September 27 complaint, the Commission alleged that Puroflow, as part of a continuing course of violative conduct, failed to file its Annual Report on Form 10-K for its fiscal year ended January 31, 1985, and its Quarterly Reports on Form 10-Q for its fiscal quarters ended May 30 and July 31, 1985. Puroflow, consenting to the Court's Judgment, admitted that it had filed late or failed to file six Annual and Quarterly Reports. (SEC v. Puroflow, Inc., USDC DC, Civil Action No. 85-3097). COMPLAINT NAMES TWENTY FIRST CENTURY DISTRIBUTION CORPORATION

The Commission filed a civil injunctive action on November 7 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against Twenty First Century Distribution Corporation of New York, New York. The complaint alleges violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws and seeks a Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief.

The Commission alleges that Century, as part of a continuing course of violative conduct extending over several years, failed to file its Annual Report on Form 10-K for its fiscal year ended June 30, 1985, filed late Annual and Quarterly Reports and failed to file Notifications of Late Filing. The Commission requests that the Court order Century to file its delinquent Annual Report and enjoin it from further violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws. (SEC v. Twenty First Century Distribution Corporation, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 85-3584). (LR-10930)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NEW ENGLAND LIFE GOVERNMENT SECURITIES TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 3 to request a hearing on an application filed by New England Life Government Securities Trust, a registered diversified, open-end, management investment company, for an order exempting it from the provisions of Section 19(b) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 19b-1. The exemption will permit New England to make quarterly distributions of long-term capital gains from certain transactions in options, in futures contracts and in options on futures contracts. (Rel. CENTRAL POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY
