FEE RATE ADVISORY

The Congress and the Administration have enacted an extension to the current Continuing Resolution on fiscal 1996 funding. As a result, the Section 6(b) fee rate will be at 1/29th of one percent.

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ENERGY INITIATIVES, INC., ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Energy Initiatives, Inc. (EII), a nonutility subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation (GPU), and GPU, a registered holding company, to increase from \$200 million to \$500 million the aggregate amount which GPU is permitted to contribute or reimburse to EII or guarantee on behalf of EII (Contribution Cap); expand the purposes for which GPU may enter into guarantees on behalf of EII, subject to the limitation of the Contribution Cap, to include Guarantees of bank or other borrowings by EII; relinquish the authorization for GPU to guarantee certain promissory notes to be issued by EII; and increase from \$30 million to \$50 million the amount of liabilities of exempt wholesale generators and foreign utility companies which EII is authorized to assume. ENTERGY CORPORATION, ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Entergy Corporation (Entergy), a registered public-utility holding company, its electric public-utility subsidiary company, Arkansas Power & Light Company, its service company subsidiary, Entergy Services, Inc., and its indirect fuel supply subsidiary company, System Fuels, Inc., whereby, among other things, Entergy will engage in off-system sales of electricity through a newly formed subsidiary, Entergy Power, Inc. The Commission has denied a request for a hearing in this matter by the Louisiana Public Service Commission. (Rel. 35-26410)

WITHDRAWAL SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 7 to comment on the application of Solitron Devices, Inc. to withdraw from listing and registration on the Pacific Stock Exchange its Common Stock, \$.01 Par Value. (Rel. 34-36488)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-95-37) filed by the New York Stock Exchange relating to a pilot to display price improvement on the execution report sent to the entering firm has become effective upon filing with the Commission. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 20. (Rel. 34-36489)

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-95-52) to amend Section 1(c) of Schedule A to the NASD By-Laws to revise the credit allowed to members against the annual assessment on their gross income. (Rel. 34-36490)
