COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

FRIEND-OF-THE-COURT BRIEF FILED

Daniel L. Goelzer, the General Counsel of the Securities and Exchange Commission, announced that the Commission has filed with the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit, at the Court's invitation, a friend-of-the-court brief in Mendell v. Gollust, et al., supporting the plaintiff's standing to bring suit under Section 16(b) of the Exchange Act of 1934. That Section permits an owner of any security of an issuer to bring an action on behalf of the issuer to recover short-swing profits made by certain of an issuer's insiders in transactions involving the issuer's stock. The plaintiff in this case owned common stock of the issuer when he brought this Section 16(b) action, but he was subsequently divested of his ownership through a merger in which the issuer became a wholly-owned subsidiary of another company and his shares were exchanged for cash and shares of the parent company. The Commission's brief takes the position that the plaintiff retained his standing. (Press Release 90-7)

FOIA OFFICER'S DETERMINATION TO DENY CONFIDENTIAL TREATMENT AFFIRMED

The General Counsel sent a letter to Allen I. Young, affirming the Freedom of Information Act Officer's determination to deny a request for confidential treatment. The General Counsel determined that Young failed to comply with Commission rules requiring that substantiation of a confidential treatment request be submitted to the FOIA Office within 10 days after the requester is notified. The General Counsel noted that Young never submitted any substantiations to the FOIA Office, despite being given several opportunities to do so. (Rel. FOIA-140)

FOIA OFFICER'S DECISION AFFIRMED

The General Counsel sent a letter to Robert R. Belair, Esq., Counsel for Safecard Services, Inc., affirming the FOIA Officer's determination to make certain files on disciplinary proceedings available through the Commission's public reference room facilities, rather than through the FOIA. The General Counsel also affirmed the FOIA Officer's decision to process the remainder of Safecard's FOIA request -- which seeks numerous investigatory records -- through the Commission's first-in, first-out system for processing requests for larger numbers of documents. The General Counsel further concluded that Safecard had not demonstrated an urgent need for the documents so as to be given priority over other previously received requests for records. (Rel. FOIA OFFICER'S DETERMINATION AFFIRMED

The General Counsel sent a letter to William B. Federman, Esq., in response to his appeal under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), affirming the FOIA Officer's determination to deny access to certain investigative records. The determination to withhold the Commission's formal order of investigation was affirmed under Exemptions

5 and 7(C), 5 U.S.C. 522(b)(5) and (7)(C), rather than 7(A). The General Counsel concluded that production of the remainder of the responsive documents -- transcripts of investigatory testimony and subpoenas -- could reasonably be expected to interfere with government law enforcement proceedings, and thus the records were exempt under FOIA Exemption 7(A), 5 U.S.C. 522(b)(7)(A). ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AND SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST ANTHONY STOISICH AND ANTHONY DESTEFANO

The Commission has simultaneously instituted public administrative proceedings pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act and Section 14(b) of the Securities Investor Protection Act (SIPA), against Anthony Stoisich, the former President of Investors Center, Inc. (ICI), a defunct penny-stock broker-dealer in Hauppauge, New York and Anthony DeStefano, the former Chief Financial Officer of ICI, and accepted Stoisich's and DeStefano's Offers of Settlement.

The Commission's Order finds that Stoisich wilfully aided and abetted ICI's violation of the net capital rule and that DeStefano wilfully aided and abetted ICI's violations of the net capital, bookkeeping and financial reporting rules. The Order also finds that on March 7, 1989, a SIPA trustee was appointed for ICI, and that Stoisich and DeStefano failed to take reasonable remedial measures to prevent ICI from going into a SIPA liquidation.

Without admitting or denying the findings, Stoisich and DeStefano consented to being barred by the Commission from association with various Commission-regulated entities; DeStefano, however, has the right to reapply after four years to become associated in a non-supervisory, non-proprietary capacity. The Commission acknowledges the National Association of Securities Dealers' efforts in resolving this matter. (Rel. 34-27626)

MERITOR MONEY MARKET FUND MERITOR GROWTH OPPORTUNITIES FUND

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until February 15 and February 16, respectively, to request a hearing on applications filed by Meritor Money Market Fund, Inc. and Meritor Growth Opportunities Fund, Inc., respectively, for orders of the Commission under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act, declaring that each applicant has ceased to be an investment company. PUTNAM CALIFORNIA TAX EXEMPT INCOME FUND

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) on an application filed on behalf of various existing and future funds within the Putnam group of investment companies granting exemptions from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c), 22(d) and Rule 22c-1 to permit the imposition and waiver of a contingent deferred sales charge.
