CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES ROBERT H. BRETHEN

The New York Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney for the Southern District of Ohio announced that the Commission filed a Complaint on February 27 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Ohio, Western Division, seeking a temporary restraining order, a limited asset freeze, and other interim relief against Robert H. Brethen, former Vice Chairman and CEO of Philips Industries, Inc., a manufacturing concern based in Dayton, Ohio.

The Complaint charges Brethen with violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws arising out of his sale, on January 9 and 11, 1990, of 109,733 shares of Philips stock while in possession of material, non-public information concerning Philips' declining sales and earnings for the last quarter of 1989, and the effect of those poor results on a pending merger of Philips with the leveraged buy-out unit of Merrill Lynch Pierce Fenner & Smith, Inc. The Complaint alleges that by selling before these announcements Brethen avoided losses of at least \$570,757.38. In addition to preliminary and permanent injunctions and disgorgement of at least \$570,757.38, the Complaint seeks a penalty under the Insider Trading and Securities Fraud Enforcement Act of 1988. DART GROUP CORPORATION PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The Commission today announced the filing of a complaint against Dart Group Corporation (Dart Group), alleging that violations of Section 7(a) of the Investment Company Act. It is alleged that Dart Group has acted as an investment company since June 30, 1984, as defined in Section 3(a)(1) of the Act, without registering with the Commission. It further alleged that since that time the company has been primarily engaged in the business of investing, reinvesting and trading in securities. In its Complaint the Commission seeks a permanent injunction against violations of Section 7(a) of the Act.

Dart Group, without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's Complaint, has consented to the entry of a permanent injunction. In addition, Dart Group has agreed to report information to the Commission for three years from the entry of the judgment against it concerning its investments in securities and its income derived from its investments in securities.
