COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

EXPANSION OF MIDWEST STOCK EXCHANGE INTERIM PLAN APPROVED

The Commission approved a request for expansion of an interim plan (File S7-33-86) filed by the Midwest Stock Exchange that will permit the MSE to trade up to 100 NASDAQ/National Market System securities pursuant to a grant of unlisted trading privileges. Publication of the release in the Federal Register is expected during the week of July 2. (Rel. 34-28147)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

DAVID K. JEFFERS PERMANENTLY BARRED; JEFFERS INVESTMENTS CORPORATION REGISTRATION REVOKED

The Commission announced the institution of public proceedings against Jeffers Investments Corporation, a registered broker-dealer, and its President, David K. Jeffers. Simultaneously with the institution of these proceedings, Jeffers and Jeffers Investments submitted an offer of settlement. Without admitting or denying the findings contained in the Commission's order, except for the finding that they were permanently enjoined, Jeffers and Jeffers Investments consented to the entry of the Order Instituting Proceedings, Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions. The Order finds that Jeffers and Jeffers Investments violated the registration and general antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws, that Jeffers aided and abetted Jeffers Investments' violations of the broker-dealer antifraud provisions, and that they were permanently enjoined from further violations of these provisions. Specifically, Jeffers and Jeffers Investments raised \$1.2 million from investors through the fraudulent offer and sale of securities in the form of short-term notes by, among other things, misrepresenting the risks associated with the investment and the uses to which investors' monies would be put. The Commission revoked Jeffers Investments' registration and permanently barred Jeffers from association with the securities industry. (Rel. 34-28135)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES HERMAN J. SCHANNAULT, OTHERS

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announced the filing of a Complaint on June 14 against Herman J. Schannault of Boca Raton, Florida; Leslie S. Greyling of

Coral Springs, Florida; Arlene J. Brown of Boynton Beach, Florida; and Edwin Tunick of Fort Lauderdale, Florida. The Complaint seeks to enjoin the defendants from further violations of the antifraud and registration provisions of the federal securities laws and to obtain an accounting and disgorgement from Schannault of all ill-gotten gains.

The Complaint alleges that Schannault sold American British Enterprises, Inc. (American British) common stock to the public in violation of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The Complaint also alleges that between August 1987 and July 1988 Schannault, Brown, Tunick and Greyling prepared and distributed misleading due diligence packages to broker-dealers in an attempt to persuade them to become market makers in American British stock. The Complaint further alleges that Tunick prepared and audited false and misleading financial statements which appeared in the due diligence packages. [SEC v. Herman J. Schannault, Leslie S. CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

MICHAEL S. DOUGLAS INDICTED

The Chicago Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney for the Northern District of Illinois announced that, on June 19, a federal grand jury in Chicago returned an eight-count indictment against Michael S. Douglas (Douglas). The indictment charges that, beginning in 1987, Douglas engaged in a \$45 million scheme to defraud 300 investors who had invested money in three entities Douglas controlled. The indictment charges that Douglas offered and sold unregistered securities to the public in the form of limited partnership interests in D&S Trading Group, Ltd., Analytic Trading Systems, Inc., and Analytic Trading Service, Inc. According to the indictment, Douglas converted over \$6.7 million investor funds to his own use and purchased real estate and automobiles with investor funds.

On November 30, 1989, in an action brought by the Commission in the Northern District of Illinois and arising out of the same facts, Judge James H. Alesia entered an Order of Permanent Injunction against Douglas and the above-named entities, enjoining them from future violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. A receiver was also appointed, and has been accumulating and liquidating assets of the defendants in the Commission action. [United States v. Michael S. Douglas, 90 CR 557 ND IL] (LR-12522)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

HENDERSON INTERNATIONAL GROWTH FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 17 to request a hearing on an application filed by Henderson International Growth Fund (formerly, Henderson Global Asset Trust) ("Trust"), Henderson International, Inc. and certain life insurance companies and variable life insurance separate accounts investing in the Trust for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 9(a), 13(a), 15(a), and 15(b) of the Act and related Rules 6e-2(b)(15) and 6e-3(T)(b)(15) to the extent necessary to permit mixed and shared funding.
