INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE BAUPOST FUND

An order has been issued on an application filed under Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act by The Baupost Fund (Fund), Baupost Limited Partnership 1985 E-1 (Partnership), and four affiliated persons of the Fund and the Partnership exempting applicants from Section 17(a) of the Act to permit the Partnership to transfer all of its assets and liabilities to the Fund in exchange for Fund shares, which will then

be distributed to the partners of the Partnership. The exemption will allow the Partnership, a private investment partnership that has not been registered under the Act, to reorganize as a registered open-end investment company. (Rel. IC-17857 - November 15)

FLEXSECURE

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that Flexsecure has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-17858 - November 15)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NORTHEAST UTILITIES

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 7, 1990 to request a hearing on a proposal by Northeast Utilities (Northeast), a registered holding company, and its subsidiary companies, Western Massachusetts Electric Company (WMECO), The Quinnehtuk Company (Quinnehtuk), The Connecticut Light and Power Company (CL&P), Northeast Utilities Service Company (Service), Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (Nuclear), The Rocky River Realty Company (Rocky River) and Holyoke Water Power Company (Holyoke). These companies propose to seek separate authority, through December 31, 1992, to issue short-term notes to the system's money pool and/or banks, to issue and sell commercial paper, to acquire short-term notes and to make open account advances, or a combination thereof, in the following maximum amounts: Northeast, \$135 million; CL&P, \$300 million; WMECO, \$95 million; Holyoke, \$10 million; Nuclear, \$50 million; Rocky River, \$55 million; Quinnehtuk, \$5 million; and Service, \$65 million. INDIANA ENERGY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 7, 1990 to request a hearing on a proposal by Indiana Energy, Inc. (IEI), a public-utility holding company which is exempt from registration under Section 3(a)(1) of the Act pursuant to Rule 2. By order dated June 1, 1990 (HCAR No. 25099), IEI was authorized to acquire all of the issued and outstanding shares of Richmond Gas Corporation (Richmond) and Terre Haute Gas Corporation (Terre Haute), each an Indiana gas utility company. IEI now proposes to reorganize its ownership of Richmond and Terre Haute by selling all of the common stock of such companies to Indiana Gas Company, Inc., also a wholly owned gas utility subsidiary of IEI. GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 7, 1990 to request a hearing on a proposal by Georgia Power Company (GPC), an electric public-utility subsidiary company of The Southern Company, a registered holding company. GPC proposes to sell, pursuant to a proposed Agreement of Sale and Exchange, to Oglethorpe Power Corporation (OPC), a Georgia Electric Membership Generation & Transmission Corporation, all of GPC's right, title and interest in and to: (1) the real and personal property, including engineering drawings, comprising up to one hundred one

of GPC's distribution substation facilities; (2) the real and personal property comprising two of GPC's transmission tap lines; and (3) the revenue metering equipment associated with the distribution substation facilities for an aggregate price of \$17,594,057. In addition, GPC proposes to convey to OPC all of GPC's right, title and interest in and to the real and personal property, including engineering drawings, comprising the Jackson E.M.C. #13 Substation Facility, in exchange for all of OPC's right, title and interest in and to the real and personal property comprising the Dillard Substation Facilities. NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 7, 1990 to request a hearing on a proposal by National Fuel Gas Company, a registered holding company, to issue and sell from time to time through October 31, 1995, under an exception from competitive bidding, up to 1 million shares of its authorized but unissued shares of common stock to its Customer Stock Purchase Plan. A. AHLSTROM CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 7, 1990 to request a hearing on the application of A. Ahlstrom Corporation for an order exempting it under Section 3(a)(5) of the Act as a foreign holding company that derives no material part of its income from public-utility operations within the United States. Two orders have been issued granting the applications of the Great American Holding Company to strike from listing and registration on the Cincinnati Stock Exchange and Pacific Stock Exchange the following: 13-1/4% Senior Extendable Reset Notes; 14-1/8% Senior Notes (Rel. 34-28621); and 14-3/8% Senior Subordinated Debentures; 11% Senior Debentures (Rel. 34-28622).

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PARTIAL ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted partial approval of a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act by the Midwest Stock Exchange (SR-MSE-90-17) to extend its pilot program whereby the guaranteed execution price of small agency market orders received over the Midwest Automated Execution System (MAX) will be improved from the consolidated best bid or offer according to predefined criteria (SuperMAX) until May 14, 1991. The MSE also requests permanent approval for SuperMAX. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of November 19. (Rel. 34-28617)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved two proposed rule changes filed by the American Stock Exchange under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act: SR-AMEX-90-17 to permit options principal members and limited trading permit holders to trade certain derivative products in addition to standardized options (Rel. 34-28612); and SR-AMEX-90-14 to allow the AMEX to list long-term put and call options on a broad market index which will be computed at one-twentieth the value of the AMEX's Major Market Index (Rel. 34-28613). Publication of the orders is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 19.
