ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

EDWARD WELCH ORDERED TO CEASE AND DESIST FROM COMMITTING OR CAUSING ANY VIOLATION OR FUTURE VIOLATION OF SECTIONS 10(b) AND 13(b)(5) OF THE EXCHANGE ACT AND RULES 10b-5 AND 13b2-1

The Commission has instituted public administrative proceedings pursuant to Section 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) against Edward Welch (Welch), a former software sales executive at KnowledgeWare, Inc. (KnowledgeWare). Simultaneously with the institution of the proceedings, the Commission accepted a settlement offer from Welch wherein Welch consented, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, to the entry of an order directing Welch to cease and desist from committing or causing any violation, and from committing or causing any future violation, of Sections 10(b) and 13(b)(5) of the Exchange Act and Rules 10b-5 and 13b2-1 (Order). The Commission found that Welch violated these provisions by knowingly taking part in a fraudulent scheme whereby phony software sales were used to inflate KnowledgeWare's quarterly earnings during its fiscal year ended June 30, 1994. COMMISSION SUSTAINS NASD DISCIPLINARY ACTION AGAINST JOHN CHEPAK

The Commission sustained the NASD's disciplinary action against John A. Chepak, a former vice-president and director of compliance for Thomas James Associates, Inc., then an NASD member firm. The NASD found that Chepak failed to adequately supervise the sales and trading activities of the firm, specifically relating to Acqua

Group, Inc. from December 1990 to April 1991, which resulted in excessive ~~markups~~ and markdowns totaling \$419,490 and that Chepak failed to establish proper supervisory procedures. The NASD censured Chepak, fined him \$5,000 and required him to requalify, by examination within 90 days of the decision, in all capacities in which he seeks to continue participating in the securities industry.

The Commission also found that the supervisory procedures that Chepak helped develop were deficient in that the procedures did not inform employees of the NASD's Markup Policy, nor was there any mechanism established to detect pricing violations. The Commission also found that Chepak acceded his supervisory responsibilities to Paul J. Yesawich, III, a court appointed special counsel and Philip McMorrow, Yesawich's "oversight consultant," though neither were registered in any capacity.

The Commission rejected Chepak's claim that he feared discipline by the District Court if he did not obey the special counsel's consultant. The Commission found that Chepak did not seek the advice of counsel or the court, nor did he inform McMorrow that he could not adequately perform his job if he did not oversee trading. CIVIL ACTION AGAINST FRANCIS TARKENTON, DONALD ADDINGTON, RICK GOSSETT, LEE FONTAINE, WILLIAM HAMMERSLA, III, ELADIO ALVAREZ AND EDWARD WELCH

The Commission announced today that it accepted settlement offers made by the last two defendants in the civil injunctive action that the Commission filed on September 28, 1999, in federal court in Atlanta, Georgia against seven former executives of KnowledgeWare, Inc. (KnowledgeWare), a computer software company. The Commission's complaint alleges that the defendants carried out a multi-million dollar financial fraud scheme that materially inflated KnowledgeWare's reported earnings during KnowledgeWare's fiscal year ended June 30, 1994 (Fiscal Year 1994), and further alleges that two of those defendants engaged in illegal insider trading.

Five of the defendants settled the Commission's charges on the same day that the federal court action was filed, and four other former KnowledgeWare executives settled administrative proceedings also commenced that day by the Commission.

The two remaining defendants in the federal court action are:

Eladio Alvarez (Alvarez), age 42, was a District Sales Manager in KnowledgeWare's Direct Sales Group.

Edward Welch (Welch), age 56, was a District Sales Manager in KnowledgeWare's Reseller Channel Sales group.

The Commission's complaint alleges that the defendants engaged in a fraudulent scheme to inflate KnowledgeWare's financial results to meet sales and earnings projections. In all, KnowledgeWare reported at least \$8 million in revenue from sham software sales.

KnowledgeWare "parked" inventory with software resellers and other supposed customers that were given the right not to pay for the software, either orally or in "side letters" that were kept separate from the other sales documents. Alvarez and Welch implemented the fraudulent scheme by using "side letters" to create some of these sham software sales and received excess incentive compensation as a result of the sham sales. In addition, Alvarez engaged in illegal insider trading by using material nonpublic information regarding the status of KnowledgeWare's prospective acquisition by Sterling Software, Inc. when he sold all his shares of KnowledgeWare stock in August 1994.

In his settlement offer, Alvarez consented, without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint, to the issuance of a final judgment permanently enjoining him from (i) committing securities fraud in violation of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 or Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rule 10b-5; and (ii) falsifying corporate books and records or engaging in other conduct in violation of Section 13(b)(5) of the Exchange Act or Rule 13b2-1. Alvarez also agreed to disgorge, and pay prejudgment interest on, the following two amounts: (i) \$42,354, representing the incentive compensation he received as a result of his violative conduct in connection with the financial fraud scheme; and (ii) \$16,368, representing the losses he avoided by illegally selling KnowledgeWare stock. In addition, Alvarez agreed to pay civil money penalties totaling \$26,368, consisting of a \$10,000 penalty in connection with his financial fraud violations and a \$16,368 penalty in connection with his insider trading violations.

The settlement with Welch involved the institution of administrative proceedings against Welch in lieu of the federal court action. Pursuant to Welch's settlement offer, the Commission dismissed the federal court action as to Welch and instead issued an administrative order finding that Welch violated Sections 10(b) and 13(b)(5) of the Exchange Act and Rules 10b-5 and 13b2-1, and directing Welch to: (i) cease and desist from committing or causing violations of Sections 10(b) and 13(b)(5) of the Exchange Act and Rules 10b-5 and 13b2-1; and (ii) disgorge and pay prejudgment interest on \$16,158, which amount represents the excess incentive compensation that Welch received as a result of his violative conduct. Welch consented to the issuance of this order without admitting or denying the Commission's findings. For further information, see Securities Exchange Act Release No. 34-42355. [SEC v. Francis A. DEFAULT JUDGMENT ISSUED AGAINST STIEGHORST, NEUHAUS AND AFFIDA BANK ACCOUNT OWNERS IN SEC v. CAVANAGH

On January 21, the Honorable Denise L. Cote of the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York issued a default judgment against relief defendants Bernd Stieghorst,

Jean-Pierre Neuhaus and The Owners of Account No. 13601/Cumbre at Affida Bank of Zurich (now Bank Leu). The Court ordered these overseas relief defendants, who received free Electro-Optical Systems Corp. (EOSC) shares or proceeds from the sale of those shares, to disgorge the sale proceeds and any EOSC shares they retain. Stieghorst, of Cologne, Germany, was ordered to pay \$271,281 in EOSC sale proceeds and \$26,061.46 in prejudgment interest and to disgorge 24,000 shares of EOSC stock. Neuhaus, of Zurich, Switzerland, was ordered to pay \$565,031 in EOSC sale proceeds and \$5,281.45 in prejudgment interest and to disgorge 34,000 shares of EOSC stock. The Affida account owners were ordered to pay \$1,000,000 in EOSC sale proceeds and \$96,068.10 in prejudgment interest, subject to reduction for payments received by the Court from specified defendants and relief defendants in excess of \$8,904,111.71.

This default judgment follows two earlier default judgments issued on July 23, 1999, and November 19, 1999, against various other defendants and relief defendants. The payments for disgorgement ordered by all three default judgments exceed \$10 million. The default judgments provide that all disgorged funds received in this action are to be equitably distributed to defrauded retail investors at the conclusion of this action.

This action, which has unadjudicated claims against contesting defendants and relief defendants, is presently stayed pending a criminal investigation. [SEC v. Cavanagh, et al., 98 Civ. 1818, DLC, USDC, SDNY] (LR-16419)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

EVERGREEN SELECT FIXED INCOME TRUST, ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Evergreen Select Fixed Income Trust, et al., under Section 12(d)(1)(J) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from Sections 12(d)(1)(A) and (B) of the Act, under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Act for an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Act, and under Section 17(d) of the Act and Rule 17d-1 under the Act to permit certain joint transactions. The order permits certain registered management investment companies to invest uninvested cash and cash collateral in affiliated money market funds. (Rel. IC-24260 - January 24)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change (SR-BSE-99-15) filed by the Boston Stock Exchange relating to

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-99-61) amending its rules governing notification requirements and assessment of fees under its Listing of Additional Shares Program.
