ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST SYSTEMS OF EXCELLENCE, INC. SEEKING TO REVOKE THE REGISTRATION OF ITS COMMON STOCK

On April 4, the Commission instituted administrative proceedings pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Systems of Excellence, Inc. (SOE), of McLean, Virginia and Coral Gables, Florida. The purpose of the proceedings is to determine whether SOE violated provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Exchange Act, and to determine whether the registration of SOE's securities should be revoked.

The Division of Enforcement alleges that during 1995 and 1996, SOE engaged in a massive unregistered distribution of its common stock, that SOE issued a series of materially false and misleading press releases touting its success in the video-teleconferencing business and announcing other corporate developments, and that SOE filed with the Commission twenty-seven registration statements on Form S-8, an annual report on Form 10-KSB, a quarterly report on Form 10-QSB, and a current report on Form 8-K, all of which were materially false and misleading

The Division further alleges that SOE has failed to file any quarterly or annual reports required pursuant to Section 13(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 13a-1 and 13a-13 thereunder. As a result of the foregoing, the Division alleges that SOE violated Sections 5(a), 5(c), and 17(a) of the Securities Act, Sections 10(b) and 13(a) of the Exchange Act, and Exchange Act Rules 10b-5, 13a-1, 13a-11, and 13a-13.

A hearing will be scheduled to take evidence on the Division's allegations, to afford SOE the opportunity to establish defenses to these allegations, and to determine whether the registration of SOE's securities pursuant to Section 12(g) of the Exchange Act should be revoked. INTERNET TOUTING ACTION FILED AGAINST DOMINIC ROELANDT AND STEPHEN MAREK

On April 4, the Commission filed an Internet touting action against Dominic Roelandt of Belgium, using the name "Coldstocks," and Stephen B. Marek, formerly of Salome, Arizona and now located in British Columbia, using the names "BigProfitNews" and "Bulls-Eye Stocks." The complaint alleges that, often in combination, Roelandt and Marek touted the stocks in free e-mail newsletters and on Internet websites in the names of the three entities from at least June 1999 through March 17, 2000.

The complaint, filed in United States District Court for the District of Arizona, alleges that the e-mail messages or websites contained various false and misleading statements concerning the claimed performance of Marek's and Roelandt's past stock picks, their trading intentions, and compensation received by Marek. The Commission's action seeks a temporary restraining order to prohibit Roelandt and Marek from violating the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws, a freeze of Marek's assets, an accounting and repatriation of assets.

According to the complaint, in several instances, Roelandt and Marek sold their personal holdings in the stocks immediately after sending the e-mail messages to thousands of subscribers, thereby realizing at least \$41,958 and \$100,835 in profits, respectively. PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed with the Commission a notice of filing of a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NASD-00-02) amending NASD Code of Arbitration Rules 10335 and 10205(h) regarding injunctive relief. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of April 10. (Rel. 34-42606)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission has approved a proposed rule change filed by the Depository Trust Company (SR-DTC-99-22) under Section 19(b)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act that will revise DTC's procedures for running call lotteries on book entry only securities when DTC receives notice of the call after the redemption date (Rel. 34-42584)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-Amex-98-33) by the American Stock Exchange to allow specified Portfolio Depository Receipts or Index Fund Shares to serve as cover for short positions in options on specified indexes. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of April 10. (Rel. 34-42605)

A proposed rule change (SR-MSRB-00-05) filed by the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board relating to interpreting MSRB Rule G-38 has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act.
