ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS SETTLED AGAINST CESAR ODIO

On April 14, the Commission entered an Order Making Findings and Imposing a Cease And Desist Order (Order) against Cesar Odio of Miami, Florida. The Commission accepted Odio's Offer of Settlement, in which he agreed to an order for him to cease and desist from committing or causing any violations of, and any future violation of, Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder.

The Order finds that while Odio was the City Manager of Miami, Florida he committed or caused the city of Miami to violate the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws in connection with Miami's issuance of its Comprehensive Annual Financial Statement in February 1995 and its sale of three bonds later that year. GOLD ASSET MANAGEMENT, INC. AND MARK GOLD CONSENT TO FINDING THAT THEY USED FALSE AND MISLEADING PERFORMANCE ADVERTISING

On April 14, the Commission simultaneously instituted and settled administrative and cease and desist proceedings against Gold Asset Management, Inc., a registered investment advisory firm with offices in Great Falls, Virginia and Steamboat Springs, Colorado, and its principal, Marc L. Gold, for their use of false and misleading advertising of their investment performance.

The Commission found that between June 1996 and September 1997, Gold Asset Management and Marc Gold distributed an advertising circular, which misrepresented the size and investment performance of Gold Asset Management and misrepresented the professional credentials of Marc Gold. The Commission found that Gold Asset Management and Marc Gold misrepresented that Gold Asset Management, Inc. had achieved a one-year annualized return of 54.6 percent when actual returns were between 15 and 30 percent. Further, the Commission found that they claimed assets under management of \$278 million when they had only \$30 million; and claimed to have 522 clients when they had only approximately 100 clients. The Commission also found that the circular misrepresented Marc Gold's experience

as an investment adviser and his educational qualifications as well as the qualifications and experience of Gold Asset Management's "professional staff"

The Commission found that Gold Asset Management violated Sections 206(1), 206(2) and 206(4) of the Investment Advisers Act (Advisers Act) and Rule 206(4)-1(a)(5) thereunder and that Marc Gold aided and abetted and caused such violations. Without admitting the Commission's findings, Gold Asset Management and Marc Gold consented to the entry of the Order that requires them to cease and desist from further violations, and imposes a \$20,000 penalty. The Order further requires Gold Asset Management and Marc Gold to comply with their undertakings to retain an independent consultant to examine and to verify to the Commission the firm's investment returns and assets under management and to send a copy of the Order to current clients and to prospective clients for one year. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NATIONS FUND TRUST AND BANC OF AMERICA ADVISORS, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 8, 2000, to request a hearing on an application filed by Nations Fund Trust and Banc of America Advisors, Inc for an order under Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act granting an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Act to permit certain series of a registered open-end management investment company to acquire all of the assets and assume all of the liabilities of certain other series of the investment company. Because of certain affiliations, applicants may not rely on Rule 17a-8 under the Act. (Rel. IC-24392 – April 13)

The International Securities Exchange and the National Association of Securities Dealers filed a plan for the allocation of regulatory responsibilities under Rule 17d-2 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposed plan is expected in the Federal Register during the week of April 17. (Rel. 34-42668)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change and Amendment Nos. 1 and 2 to the proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-00-12) related to original and continued listing standards for affiliated companies.
