CHANGE IN THE MEETING: CANCELLATION

The closed meeting scheduled for Wednesday, November 8, 2000, at 11:00 a.m. has been cancelled.

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION GRANTED IN CONNECTION WITH \$159 MILLION INTERNET OFFERING FRAUD

On November 1, the Honorable David O. Carter, United States District Judge, Central District of California, issued a preliminary injunction in a multi-million dollar securities fraud case. The Court's order, superseding a temporary restraining order, requires defendants Ernest F. Cossey (Cossey) and Gary W. Williams (Williams), entities controlled by them (TLC Entities), and Thomas G. Cloud (Cloud) and his company to cease further fraud and continues the asset freeze over all defendants' assets; made permanent the appointment of Robb Evans as receiver; ordered two of the defendants' attorneys to return \$217,500 to the receivership estate; denied living expenses to Cossey, and granted other relief.

The Commission's complaint, filed on October 3, 2000, alleges that Cossey, Williams and the TLC Entities operated a real estate Ponzi scheme using investor funds to make interest payments. In addition, Cossey and Williams have misused at least \$28.3 million in investor funds. The Receiver's initial findings indicate that Cossey, Williams and the TLC entities collectively raised over \$159 million from over 1,800 investors, most of whom are elderly, and the receivership estate holds approximately \$2.5 million in cash and real estate purchased and developed at a cost of approximately \$61 million. The Commission further alleged that Cloud and his company, Cloud & Associates Consulting, Inc. (C&A), falsely claimed C&A had received no commissions when, in fact, C&A has received at least \$1 million in commissions through July 2000.

The Commission obtained a preliminary injunction that prohibits Cossey, Williams, the TLC Entities, C&A and Cloud from committing securities fraud in violation of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act), Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The defendants (except Williams) were also preliminarily enjoined from committing violations of the securities registration provisions of Sections 5(a) and 5(c) of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act). In addition to the relief already granted, the Commission seeks a final judgment against Cossey, Williams, the TLC entities, Cloud & Associates and Cloud enjoining them from future violations of Sections 5(a) and 5(c) of the Securities Act (except for Williams), Section 17(a) of the Securities Act, Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, ordering them to disgorge all ill-gotten gains, and pay civil penalties. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE PRINCIPAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 27 to request a hearing on an application filed by Principal Life Insurance Company (Principal Life), Principal Life Insurance Company Separate Account B (Account), and Princor Financial Services Corporation (collectively, Applicants). Applicants seek an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 22(c), and 27(i)(2)(A) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder, to permit the recapture of certain credits applied to purchase payments made under (i) certain deferred variable annuity contracts that Principal Life issues through the Account (Contracts), and (ii) contracts that Principal Life may issue in the future through the Account, any of its other separate accounts, or any separate accounts that it may establish in the future (Future Accounts) which contracts are substantially similar in all material respects to the Contracts (Future Contracts). Applicants also request that the order extend to any other National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc., member broker-dealer controlling, controlled by, or under common control with Principal Life, whether existing or created in the future, that serves as a distributor or principal underwriter of the Contracts or any Future Contracts offered through the Account or any Future Accounts. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

EXELON CORPORATION, ET AL.

An order has been issued on a proposal by Exelon Corporation (Exelon), a newly registered holding company, its utility subsidiaries PECO Energy Company (PECO) and

Commonwealth Edison Company (ComEd) and its nonutility subsidiaries Exelon Business Services Company, Exelon Ventures Company, Exelon Enterprises Company, LLC, Exelon Generation Company, LLC and Exelon Energy Delivery Company (together, Applicants). Applicants request authority to engage in a variety of financing and related transactions following a reorganization that resulted in Exelon becoming a registered holding company over PECO and ComEd.
