ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

DATE SET FOR SUSPENSION IMPOSED ON RAYMOND L. DIRKS

In July 1985, the Commission suspended Raymond L. Dirks, of New York City, from association with any broker or dealer in a proprietary or supervisory capacity for six months. The sanction was based on the Commission's finding that Dirks, a partner in the brokerage firm of John Muir & Co., was derelict in fulfilling his managerial responsibilities, and shared responsibility for Muir's financial collapse that led to the appointment of a SIPC trustee to liquidate the firm in August 1981.

Dirk's suspension was stayed pending appeal. The Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit recently affirmed the Commission's order. Accordingly, the Commission has ordered that Dirks' suspension be made effective as of January 12, 1987. (Rel. SIPA-132)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AND SETTLED AGAINST MICHAEL N. DAVID

The New York Regional Office announced that a civil injunctive action filed on December 19, 1986 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York against Michael N. David was settled. As part of the settlement, David admitted to the allegations in the Commission's complaint and consented to the Final Consent Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Relief, restraining him from violating the antifraud and tender provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and ordering him to pay \$50,000 in disgorgement and a civil penalty of not more than \$100,000 over an 11-year period.

The December 8, 1986 complaint alleged that David, formerly a corporate/bankruptcy associate attorney with the New York City law firm of Paul, Weiss, Rifkind Wharton & Garrison, violated the antifraud and tender offer provisions. According to the complaint, David misappropriated material nonpublic information concerning certain proposed, considered or anticipated takeovers involving Paul Weiss clients including but not limited to GAF Corp. and Dominion Textile, and provided this information to others who traded securities of the takeover targets while in possession of it, or conveyed the information to others who traded while in possession of it. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL LIFE ASSURANCE COMPANY OF NEW YORK

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 23 to request a hearing on an application filed by American International Life Assurance Company of New York, AIG Variable Account A, and American International Fund Distributors, Inc., for an order granting exemptions from Sections 26(a) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges in connection with the issuance of individual single purchase payment deferred variable annuity contracts. PILGRIM GOVERNMENT SECURITIES FUND

An order has been issued on an application filed by Pilgrim Government Securities Fund, Pilgrim High Income Fund, and Pilgrim International Bond Fund (Applicants), open-end, diversified management investment companies organized as limited partnerships, exempting Applicants' managing general partners from the provisions of Section 2(a)(19) of the Investment Company Act to the extent they are deemed interested persons solely due to their status as partners of Applicants. CENTRAL JERSEY INVESTMENT COMPANY

An order has been issued exempting Central Jersey Investment Company, a Delaware corporation which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of a New Jersey banking institution, from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-15508 - Dec. 30, 1986)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

YANKEE ATOMIC ELECTRIC COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Yankee Atomic Electric Company, an indirect subsidiary of New England Electric System and Northeast Utilities, to issue and sell to banks and to other financial institutions, from time-to-time through December 31, 1988, short-term promissory notes and commercial paper up to a maximum aggregate amount to be outstanding at any one time of \$25 million. The issuance and sale of commercial paper will be pursuant to an exception from competitive bidding. (Rel. 35-24284 - Dec. 24, 1986)

ASSOCIATED NATURAL GAS COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Associated Natural Gas Company, subsidiary of Arkansas Power & Light Company, to issue its unsecured, short-term promissory notes to a bank in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$3 million at any one time outstanding from time to time for up to one year.
