## RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

### APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT TO RULE 3a12-8

The Commission approved an amendment to Rule 3a12-8 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 to permit the trading of futures on designated foreign government debt securities on contract markets that are not located in the country that issued those securities, so long as the Rule's other requirements are satisfied. Rule 3a12-8 previously required that any such futures sold in the U.S. be traded on contract markets located in the country that issued the underlying debt securities. (Rel. 34-24209)

## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

### HEARING ON FINANCIAL GUARANTEES SCHEDULED

The Commission will hold a hearing on March 23rd from 1:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. in the Commission Meeting Room, Room 1C30. Subject will be the study of the use of the exemption in Section 3(a)(2) of the Securities Act of 1933, 15 U.S.C. 77c(a)(2), for securities guaranteed by banks and the use of insurance policies to guarantee securities. The study is being conducted pursuant to Section 105 of the Government Securities Act of 1986 (Pub. L. No. 99-571).

Interested individuals and organizations will discuss: (1) the use of the exemption in Section 3(a)(2) and its impact on investor protection and the public interest; (2) the impact of that exemption on competition among banks and insurance companies and domestic and foreign guarantors; and (3) whether and under what circumstances debt securities guaranteed by insurance policies should be exempt from registration.

## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

---

### CAPITAL SUNBELT SECURITIES, INC., OTHERS SANCTIONED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Capital Sunbelt Securities, Inc., Silas T. Patrick, and John D. Burkey under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The Order for Proceedings alleges that on November 4, 1986 Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction were entered against respondents, enjoining them from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Exchange Act, and enjoining Capital Sunbelt Securities from further violations of, and Patrick and Burkey from further aiding and abetting violations of, the broker-dealer antifraud provisions of the Exchange Act. Simultaneous with the institution of proceedings, the Commission accepted respondents' Offers of Settlement.

Capital Sunbelt Securities consented to an Order revoking its registration with the Commission as a broker-dealer. Patrick and Burkey consented to Orders suspending them from association with any broker or dealer for 180 days and barring them from association with any broker or dealer in a supervisory or proprietary capacity with the right to reapply in three years for a supervisory or proprietary position. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
