CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

FINAL JUDGMENT OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST HEALTHDYNE, INC.

The Atlanta Regional Office announced that on June 3 U.S. District Judge Horace T. Ward, Northern District of Georgia, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Healthdyne, Inc. of Marietta, Georgia, enjoining it from future violations of certain antifraud, issuer reporting, and issuer books and records provisions of the securities laws. The Judgment was based upon the defendants' consent to the Judgment without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint.

The Complaint alleges that, in connection with securities sold in a public offering in June 1983 and securities used in an acquisition program, Healthdyne misrepresented and omitted material facts concerning problems with the operation, production, and returns of its 16900 infant monitor, projected earnings for 1983, and recognition of revenues during the third quarter of 1983. In addition, the Complaint alleges that Healthdyne misrepresented or omitted information concerning the aforementioned matters in periodic filings with the Commission. Finally, the Complaint alleges that, by following revenue recognition practices which are not recognized by generally accepted accounting principles, Healthdyne overstated its revenues for the third quarter of 1983 by \$1.2 million. The Complaint does not allege that Healthdyne acted with scienter. (SEC v. Healthdyne, Inc., USDC NDGA, Civil Action No. C87-1139A). (LR-11457)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

SUPERSEDING INDICTMENT CHARGES ROBERT L. RIDENOUR

The Chicago Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Southern District of Iowa announced that on May 27 a federal grand jury returned a four-count superseding indictment charging Robert L. Ridenour with three counts of felony tax fraud and acting as an unregistered broker-dealer. The superseding indictment alleges that Ridenour, a former registered representative, conducted transactions in U.S. Government and municipal debt securities from 1980 through 1982 and failed to report at least \$2.7 million of profits from the transactions on his federal income tax returns in violation of 26 USC §7206(1). In addition, the superseding indictment alleges that from 1982 through March 1984, Ridenour effected municipal securities transactions for the accounts of others outside the scope of his association with his employer without registering as a broker-dealer in violation of 15 USC §§78o(a)(1) and 78ff(a). (U.S. v. Robert L. Ridenour, SDIA, Criminal Action No. 87-27 [LR-11421]). (LR-11458)

The Commission previously filed a Complaint against Ridenour alleging violations of the antifraud and broker-dealer registration provisions of the securities laws and seeking a permanent injunction and disgorgement [SEC v. Robert L. Ridenour, SDIA, Civil Action No. 85-343-E, LR-10731].

CAL GAS CORPORATION

An order has been issued declaring that Cal Gas Corporation, a marketer of liquefied petroleum gas, is not a gas utility company under Section 2(a)(4) of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935. (Rel. 34-24407 - June 10)

UNLISTED TRADING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the Cincinnati Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in the common stock of 40 issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-87-10) to exempt OEX orders from the requirement that orders transmitted to a floor broker by hand signal be followed up by a written order ticket. (Rel. 34-24560)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-87-22) to amend the eligibility standards for market maker participation in its Retail Automatic Execution System in options on the Standard & Poor's 100 Index. (Rel. 34-24561); and The Boston Stock Exchange (SR-BSE-87-2) to increase the margin, net capital, collateral, and equity requirements of its specialists. (Rel. 34-24562); and (SR-BSE-86-3) to update the body of BSE rules and, where appropriate, to eliminate outdated material. (Rel. 34-24563)

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of June 8.

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

CITICORP

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 3 to request a hearing on an application by Citicorp under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the trusteeship of United States Trust Company of New York under four existing indentures and two pooling and servicing agreements each dated February 1, 1987 is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify the Trust Company from acting as trustee.

The four indentures are dated: (1) February 15, 1972, involving the issuance of floating rate notes, due 1989; (2) March 15, 1977, involving the issuance of various series unsecured and unsubordinated notes; (3) August 25, 1977, involving the issuance of rising-rate notes, Series A; and (4) April 21, 1980, involving the issuance of various series unsecured and unsubordinated notes.
