ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

ROBERT J. CHECK SUSPENDED

Chief Administrative law Judge Warren E. Blair issued an initial decision suspending Robert J. Check, of Avon, Connecticut, from association with any broker or dealer for 30 days.

Judge Blair found that Check, in violation of Section 15(b)(4)(E) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, failed reasonably to supervise salesmen of a registered broker-dealer who were subject to his supervision with a view to preventing violations of Section 17(a)(2) of the Securities Act of 1933.

DECISION BARRING EUGENE MULVIHILL FINAL

The decision of an administrative law judge barring Eugene Mulvihill, of New Vernon, New Jersey, from association with any broker or dealer has become final.

According to the law judge's decision, Mulvihill controls two registered broker-dealers. In 1984, he was convicted of using a corporation to promote a criminal purpose; doing business as an unauthorized insurance company; and tampering with and falsifying records. In order to avoid the cost of premiums for insurance required by various companies with which he was involved, Mulvihill formed an offshore corporation and utilized it to issue and distribute fictitious insurance policies and performance bonds. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

COMPAGNIE FINANCIERE DE PARIBAS

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 23 to request a hearing on an application filed by Compagnie Financiere de Paribas, for an order amending an existing order (Release IC-12948, January 6, 1983) to permit the issuance of its equity securities in the United States. MONTE DEI PASCHI DI SIENA

An order has been issued exempting Monte dei Paschi di Siena and its subsidiary, MPS U.S. Commercial Paper Corporation, from all provisions of the Investment Company Act to permit their issuance of commercial paper and other debt securities in the United States. (Rel. IC-15836 - July 1)

BUTCHER VENTURE PARTNERS I, L.P.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Butcher Venture Partners I, L.P., a Delaware limited partnership (Partnership), declaring that the Independent General Partners of the Partnership are not interested persons within the meaning of Section 2(a)(19) of the Investment Company Act, solely by reason of being general partners of the Partnership and co-partners with the Partnership's managing general partner. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION; WPL HOLDINGS, INC.

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until July 20 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24418, dated June 25: Central and South West Corporation (CSW) - a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, CSW Energy, Inc., for authority to invest up to \$49 million in (a) qualifying cogeneration facilities located in any geographic area, and (b) small power production projects located within the service territories of the member utilities of the power pools in which the CSW operating companies participate - the Electric Reliability Counsel of Texas and the Southwest Power Pool; WPL Holdings, Inc. - which presently has no significant assets, requesting an order approving its acquisition of all the outstanding common stock of Wisconsin Power and Light Company and granting it an exemption under Section 3(a)(1) of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935.

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved proposed rule changes filed by: The Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-87-17) to extend trading hours for foreign currency options. (Rel. 34-24652); and The Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (SR-MSRB-87-3) to exempt from the application of Rules G-12(f)(ii) and G-15(d)(iii) transactions in depository - eligible, same-day fund municipal securities through June 30, 1988. (Rel. 34-24661)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-87-24) to permit it to list long-term option series. (Rel. 34-24662); and The Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-87-17) to implement a six-month pilot program allowing the routing of principal limit orders through SCOREX. (Rel. 34-24663).
