INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PRUCO LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The Stock Clearing Corporation (SR-SCCP-87-2) to implement an automated customer accounts transfer system to facilitate the transfer of customer accounts between broker-dealers. (Rel. 34-24696); and The Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-87-18) to amend its Rule X to eliminate certain exceptions to the general rule that a securities depository must be used for the processing of all depository eligible transactions. Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
