ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

WILLIAM M. DeARMAN SUSPENDED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against William M. DeArman, chairman of a registered broker-dealer located in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. The Order for Proceedings finds that an Order of Permanent Injunction was entered in the District of Columbia enjoining DeArman from further violations, as a principal or an aider and abettor, of Section 5 of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 13(d) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted DeArman's Offer of Settlement. DeArman consented to a 90-day suspension from association with any broker, dealer, or investment adviser provided that at the end of the suspension he will, for an additional six months, be supervised by the office manager with respect to all transactions in securities in which the associating broker-dealer is a market-maker. Additionally, DeArman consented to comply with his undertaking to engage independent counsel to review his Rule 144 procedures. (Rel. 34-24731)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

WILLIAM DeARMAN ENJOINED

The Chicago Regional announced that on July 22 Judge Oberdorfer, U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against William M. DeArman from future violations of Sections 5(a) and 5(c) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 13(d) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. DeArman consented to the Final Judgment without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint.

The complaint alleges that DeArman, chairman of Fitzgerald, DeArman and Roberts, Inc. (FDR), an Oklahoma City, Oklahoma broker-dealer, violated the registration provisions by selling restricted Universal Money Centers, Inc. common stock in three instances for Universal Money's former chief executive officer, Henry McFlicker, and other shareholders without complying with the conditions of Rule 144 of the Securities Act. The complaint further alleges that DeArman aided and abetted McFlicker's filing of false Schedules 13D by his execution of transactions in accounts at FDR which were nominees of McFlicker. (SEC v. William M. DeArman, Civil Action No. 87-1924, JO, USDC DC, filed July 14, 1987). (LR-11498)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change by filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-87-18) to put its members and the public on notice that it may in the future alter the time at which the prices of constituent stocks would be reviewed for the purpose of calculating the final index settlement value for expiring index options. PARTIAL APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission partially approved a proposed rule change by filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-87-19) to make permanent its Standards and Poor's 500 index option contract that settles based on the opening prices of the underlying stocks on Expiration Fridays. The Commission determined to extend approval of the new index contract through the September 1987 expiration. (Rel. 34-24755)
