HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

COLUMBIA GAS TRANSMISSION CORPORATION; JERSEY CENTRAL POWER & LIGHT COMPANY; KINGSPORT POWER COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until September 21 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24449, dated August 27: Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation - subsidiary of the Columbia Gas System, Inc., to extend until July 15, 1994 the maturity date of the \$350 million limited recourse loan agreement authorized by the Commission's order of August 30, 1985 [Rel. 35-23813] and to extend its termination date until October 15, 1989; Jersey Central Power & Light Company, Metropolitan Edison Company and Pennsylvania Electric Company - subsidiaries of General Public Utilities Corporation, to issue and sell from time to time through March 31, 1989 their respective unsecured short-term promissory notes to dealers in commercial paper, pursuant to an exception from competitive bidding. The amount of commercial paper to be issued by each subsidiary would not exceed \$50 million at any one time outstanding, nor would the principal amount issued, when added to other short-term borrowings authorized by the Commission order dated October 6, 1986 [Rel. 35-24207], exceed the amount of short-term indebtedness permitted by such company's charter to be outstanding at any one time; and Kingsport Power Company and Wheeling Electric Company - subsidiaries of American Electric Power Company Inc., to extend until November 1, 1990 the maturity date of Kingsport's \$2 million loan agreement authorized by Commission orders of January 21, 1980 [Rel. 35-21401] and April 9, 1982 [Rel. 35-22453], and to extend until December 1, 1990 the maturity date of Wheeling's \$7 million loan agreement authorized by Commission orders of October 24, 1979 [Rel. 35-21265] and December 22, 1981 [Rel. 35-22332].

LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

UNLISTED TRADING SOUGHT

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NASD-87-21) that would amend Schedule E of its By-Laws. The proposal would, inter alia, exempt from Schedule E distributions by members and associated persons of securities issued by affiliates of members, which are collateralized by financing instruments and rated by a nationally recognized statistical rating organization in one of its four highest generic rating categories. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in Federal Register during the week of August 31. (Rel. 34-24855)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, proposed rule changes filed by: The Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-PHLX-87-27) to clarify that spread, straddle and combination orders in its foreign currency options contracts (FCOs) may consist of a combination of American-style and European-style FCOs. (Rel. 34-24857); (SR-Phlx-87-24 and 87-26) to (1) enable it to offer FCOs on all the underlying foreign currencies on which it currently lists and trades American-style FCOs, i.e., Australian dollar, British Pound, Canadian Dollar, Deutsche mark, European Currency Unit, French franc, Japanese yen, and the Swiss franc; and (2) change the contract denominations of the proposed FCOs.
