RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

AMENDMENT TO FORM N-SAR INSTRUCTIONS ADOPTED

The Commission adopted an amendment to the instructions for Form N-SAR under the Investment Company Act of 1940 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The amendment incorporates the change of accountant disclosure requirements of Form 8-K into Form N-SAR. (Rel. 34-25158; IC-16150)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

FORMER VIDEO STATION OFFICERS INDICTED

The Los Angeles Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney for the Central District of California announced that on November 17 an indictment was filed against Edward Joseph Atkinson, George William Atkinson, and Robert Alden MacNeil, Jr. The indictment charges the Atkinsons with fraud and reporting violations with respect to a materially false Form 10-K and Form 10-Q filed by the Video Station, Inc.; charges E. Atkinson with insider trading in Video Station stock; and charges the Atkinsons and MacNeil with perjury in testimony before officers of the Commission. G. Atkinson and E. Atkinson are alleged to have been the president and secretary/treasurer, respectively, of Video Station and directors of that company. (U.S. v. Edward Joseph Atkinson, et al., CDCA, CR No. 87-943). INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE FIRST TRUST OF INSURED MUNICIPAL BONDS

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 21 to request a hearing on an application filed by The First Trust of Insured Municipal Bonds and certain other existing unit investment trusts and open-end management investment companies sponsored or distributed by Clayton Brown & Associates, Inc., for an order permitting offers of exchange between certain existing series of those unit investment trusts and open-end management investment companies. HARTFORD LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued granting the Hartford Life Insurance Company, Hartford Life Insurance Company - Putnam Capital Accumulation Trust Separate Account, a registered unit investment trust, and Hartford Equity Sales Company, Inc. exemptions from Sections 26(a)(2) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the Account in connection with the issuance of certain individual and group flexible premium tax deferred variable annuity contracts. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MIDDLE SOUTH UTILITIES, INC.; CENTRAL POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until December 14 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24503, dated November 19: MIDDLE SOUTH UTILITIES, INC. (MSU) - a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, MSU System Services, Inc. (Services). Services requests authorization through December 31, 1989 to borrow and reborrow up to an aggregate principal amount

of \$30 million at any one time outstanding, pursuant to a new loan agreement with MSU. Subject to further authorization by the Commission, Services also proposes to negotiate a bank line or lines of credit for an aggregate principal amount of up to \$30 million at any one time outstanding, and MSU proposes to guarantee Services' obligations to any such bank(s). The aggregate principal amount of all borrowings by Services will not exceed \$30 million at any one time outstanding; and CENTRAL POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY (CP&L) - subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation, a registered holding company, to issue and sell prior to December 31, 1988, up to 1,000,000 shares of auction rate preferred stock, par value \$100 per share (Auction Preferred), in one or more series, under an exception under Rule 50(a)(5) from the competitive bidding requirements of Rule 50.

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. filed a proposed rule change which became effective upon filing under Section 19(b) (3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposal (SR-NASD-87-48) interprets Article VII, Section 1 of the NASD By-Laws to delegate to the Chairman of the NASD's Board of Governors (or the Vice Chairman in his absence) and the President of the Corporation, jointly, the authority to take such actions as they deem necessary or appropriate with respect to trading in or the operation of NASD systems. The NASD's interpretation remained in effect until November 13. (Rel. 34-25157)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
