### COMPLAINT NAMES CITISOURCE, INC., OTHERS

The New York Regional Office filed a complaint on December 28 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York seeking permanent injunctive relief against CitiSource, Inc., Marvin B. Kaplan, Robert R. Richards, Stanley M. Friedman, and Morton Karper.

The complaint alleges that each defendant participated in a fraudulent scheme in violation of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Sections 10(b) and 13(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5, 12b-20, 13a-1, and 13a-13. Specifically, the complaint alleges, among other things, that since in or about 1984, defendants engaged in a scheme pursuant to which they made materially false and misleading statements and omitted to state material facts in CitiSource's registration statement, and in the annual and quarterly reports filed by CitiSource with the Commission. These misstatements and omissions referred to the development of a hand-held computer contracted for by the City of New York and the terms of payment to a company under Kaplan's control.

Simultaneously, Kaplan and Friedman consented to a Final Consent Judgment of Permanent Injunction without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint. (SEC v. CitiSource, Inc., et al., SDNY, No. Civ. 9228). (LR-11633)

### COMPLAINT NAMES MOKAN PRODUCTIONS, LTD. AND DAVID G. RIGGS

The Chicago Regional Office filed a complaint on December 16 in the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Missouri against Mokan Productions, Ltd. and David G. Riggs. According to the complaint, Mokan and Riggs violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws by overstating Mokan's revenues and its backing of incomplete projects in an S-18 registration statement. (SEC v. Mokan Productions, Ltd. and David G. Riggs, WDMO, No. 87-1111-CV-W-8). (LR-11632)
