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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### DECISION DISCONTINUING PROCEEDINGS WITH RESPECT TO A. L. WILLIAMSON & CO. AND GROVER MACCONNELL FINAL

The decision of an administrative law judge discontinuing administrative proceedings instituted against A. L. Williamson & Co., formerly a West Caldwell, New Jersey brokerage firm, and Grover MacConnell, its president, has become final.

According to the law judge's decision, in March 1980 the firm and MacConnell unlawfully sold unregistered stock of Lilac, Inc. In addition, in December 1981, respondents were permanently enjoined, with their consent, from violating registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933, and MacConnell from violating antifraud provisions.

Despite his findings, the law judge concluded that the proceedings against respondents should be discontinued. He noted that, in another Commission proceeding, the firm's broker-dealer registration had already been revoked, and that MacConnell had been barred from association with any broker or dealer (and certain other regulated entities) with the proviso that, after two years, he could apply to become so associated in a non-proprietary and non-supervisory capacity, upon a showing of adequate supervision. As to the firm, the law judge pointed out that revocation of its registration had mooted the sanction issue. With respect to MacConnell, the law judge concluded that the violation he had found and the injunction did not warrant any sanction in addition to that already imposed in the other proceeding. 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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### NATIONAL COMMERCIAL BANKING CORPORATION OF AUSTRALIA LIMITED

### PACIFIC CENTURY TAX-EXEMPT FUNDS, INC.

An order has been issued on an application under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act of 1940 of Pacific Century Tax-Exempt Funds, Inc., registered under the Act as an open-end, diversified, management investment company, exempting Pacific: (1) from the provisions of Section 2(a)(41) of the Act and Rules 2a-4 and 22c-1 to permit it to calculate the net asset value per share of its Money Market Portfolio based on the amortized cost method of valuing assets; (2) from the provisions of Section 12(d)(3) of the Act to permit Pacific to acquire stand-by commitments from brokers and dealers; and (3) from Section 2(a)(41) of the Act to permit it to value stand-by commitments in the manner described in the application. ## THE PAINE WEBBER EQUITY TRUST, UTILITY STOCK SERIES 1

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 6 to request a hearing on an application of The Paine Webber Equity Trust, Utility Stock Series 1 (and subsequent and similar series of trusts) for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act of 1940 exempting it from the provisions of Section 14(a) of the Act and Rule 19b-1, and under Section 45(a) of the Act, granting confidential treatment for certain information. 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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### KENTUCKY POWER COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 9 to request a hearing on a proposal by Kentucky Power Company (KPCo), subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc., to issue up to \$150 million of unsecured notes through December 31, 1984, at a fixed rate of interest up to 14 percent, and no more than 200 basis points above the prime rate, either to prepay or repay notes outstanding which bear a fluctuating interest rate under an existing revolving credit agreement. KPCo also proposes to enter into hedging agreements whereby KPCo would agree to make payments of interest at a fixed rate based on a principal amount of up to \$150 million, in return for a bank's agreement to make payments of interest to KPCo based upon the same principal amount and bearing interest at a variable rate which is a function of the LIBO Rate payable by KPCo under the revolving credit agreement. ### MIDDLE SOUTH UTILITIES, INC.

A supplemental order has been issued regarding Middle South Utilities, Inc., a registered holding company, and one of its subsidiaries, Louisiana Power & Light Company, authorizing an extension of time until December 31, 1983, for the issuance and sale of common stock by the subsidiary and the acquisition thereof by the holding company. ### CONNECTICUT YANKEE ATOMIC POWER COMPANY

### EASTERN EDISON COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Eastern Edison Company (Eastern), subsidiary of Eastern Utilities Associates, and Montaup Electric Company, subsidiary of Eastern, to enter into certain transactions related to the issue of pollution control revenue bonds by the Massachusetts Industrial Finance Agency and the borrowing by Eastern of the proceeds of such bond issues, up to a maximum of \$40 million, in order to finance the construction of pollution control facilities at Montaup's generating plant. ### THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC.

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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### FILING AND IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF AMENDMENT

The Options Price Reporting Authority (OPRA) has filed an amendment to its Plan for Reporting of Consolidated Options Last Sale Reports and Quotation Information under Rule 11Aa3-2 of the Securities Exchange Act (File No. S7-988). The amendment establishes standards and procedures for OPRA's dissemination in information other than quotations and last sale reports, and requires each OPRA participant to indemnify OPRA against claims arising out of any information the participant provides to OPRA for dissemination. ### ORDER TO DETERMINE APPROVAL OR DISAPPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has issued a release instituting a proceeding under Section 19(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 19b-4 to determine whether to approve or disapprove a proposed rule change submitted by the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (SR-NASD-83-13) which proposes fees for the full quotation data stream for National Market System Securities. (Rel. 34-20089)

### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The New York Stock Exchange, Inc. has filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NYSE-83-32) to specify the index multiplier, strike price intervals, expiration series and expiration dates for the NYSE's composite index group options. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of August 22. (Rel. 34-20090)

### APPROVAL AND WITHDRAWAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has approved a proposed rule change filed by the National Securities Clearing Corporation (SR-NSCC-83-10). The proposed rule change enhances NSCC's comparison operation for over-the-counter debt securities transactions by providing participants with Demand As Of, Regular Withhold and Demand Withhold services. The proposed rule change, among other things, also amends NSCC's fee structure to charge participants fees that are scaled according to participants' timeliness of response to certain comparison reports related to the new enhancements. The Commission also has ordered the withdrawal of a previous, almost identical filing (SR-NSCC-83-9). (Rel. 34-20092)

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### GTE CORPORATION
