RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

NOTIFICATION OF MAJOR ALTERATIONS TO PRIVACY ACT SYSTEMS OF RECORDS

The Commission is revising its Agency Correspondence Tracking System (ACTS) (SEC-29) and the Office of Personnel Training Files (SEC-40). As revised, ACTS will have subsystems for records collected and maintained by the Office of Investor Education and Assistance (Subsystem A), the Office of the Chairman (Subsystem B), the Office of Filings and Information Services; (Subsystem C), and the Office of Information Technology (Subsystem D). SEC-40, as revised, will be called "Personnel Management Training Files" and incorporate information about its automated records. In addition, there will be changes to the systems' location, authority for maintenance, purpose, categories of individuals covered by the system, categories of records in the system, routine uses, storage, safeguards, retrievability, retention and disposal schedules, system manager(s) and address(es), record source categories, and record access, contesting record, and notification procedures. The changes to both systems will take effect 40 days after publication in the Federal Register, unless the Commission receives comments that would warrant further action. NOTIFICATION OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A NEW PRIVACY ACT SYSTEM OF RECORDS

The Commission is establishing a computerized system of records, Confidential Treatment Request Imaging System (SEC-26). This new system is being established in order to enhance the Commission's ability to store and retrieve confidential treatment requests received by the Office of Freedom of Information Act and Privacy Act Operations (FOIA/PA Office) after June 1992. Since this system may be used to retrieve information about individuals by a word search, the Privacy Act of 1974, as amended, requires a general notice of its existence to the public. The system will be used by the staff of the FOIA/PA Office to process requests under the FOIA for agency records; by other Commission staff to process subpoenas and discovery requests, in connection with pending judicial or administrative proceedings; and by Commission staff and Commission contractors who service the system. The new system of records will take effect 40 days after publication in the Federal Register,

NOTIFICATION OF DELETION, MODIFICATION, AND REDESIGNATION OF PRIVACY ACT SYSTEMS OF RECORDS

The Commission is abolishing four records systems that are either duplicative of a government-wide records system; not retrieved by name or personal identifier, and, therefore, not a Privacy Act system; not implemented or in effect; or obsolete. The Commission is also modifying forty-one systems that involve updating the Commission's address as reflected in the system locations, system manager(s) and address, retention and disposal, notification procedures, and record access procedures, due to recent office moves. Finally, the release would revise the Federal Register's biennial compilation of Federal Agency Privacy Act System Notices by redesignating/renumbering the Commission's records systems and by deleting Appendix A and replacing it with a Table of Contents. These actions will take effect upon publication in the Federal Register. (Rel. PA-20)

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST LLOYD NEWTON IN INTERLINK FRAUD

The Commission has instituted an administrative proceeding against Lloyd John Newton of Evergreen, Colorado pursuant to Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933 and Sections 15(b), 19(h), and 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The Commission is seeking an Order against Mr. Newton requiring him to cease and desist from violating Sections 5(a), 5(c) and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, to disgorge ill-gotten gains, plus interest, and to pay civil penalties, due to his actions in offering and selling securities in Interlink Data Network of Los Angeles, Interlink Fiber Optic Partners, and Interlink Video Phone Partners. The Interlink entities were promoted as installers and sellers of video phones as well as transmitters and switches of the video phone signals using fiber optic cables installed by the Interlink entities.

The Division of Enforcement of the Commission alleges that Mr. Newton participated in the fraudulent sale of unregistered securities in the Interlink companies and partnerships. Some of the materially false and misleading misrepresentations made by Mr. Newton related to Interlink Data's alleged ownership of proprietary fiber optic technology, its supposed installation of fiber optic cable, the imminent public trading of its common stock, the use of the investor's proceeds, and the promised return on the investments. Mr. Nelson also caused investors to falsely certify their net worth

and income in order to attempt to exempt the Interlink securities from the Commission's requirements that the securities be registered with the Commission.

The Division alleges that Mr. Newton sold over \$700,000 of Interlink securities to over 40 investors while he was associated with Interlink and Portfolio Asset Management, a broker-dealer used by Interlink. He was a team leader and participated in public meetings and a trade show held for potential investors. Mr. Newton allegedly solicited unaccredited and unqualified investors nationwide through unsolicited telephone calls and leads developed from cable television and radio advertisements and nationwide distribution of promotional videos and pamphlets. PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION, APPOINTMENT OF TRUSTEE, FREEZE OF ASSETS AND OTHER RELIEF AGAINST THE INFINITY GROUP COMPANY, GEOFFREY BENSON AND GEOFFREY O'CONNOR

On September 4, the Honorable Stewart Dalzell entered an Order of Preliminary Injunction, Appointment of a Trustee, Freeze of Assets and Other Relief (Order) against defendants The Infinity Group Company (TIGC), Geoffrey P. Benson (Benson) and Geoffrey J. O'Connor (O'Connor). The Order was entered following a two day hearing before Judge Dalzell in United States District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania. The Commission instituted the civil injunctive action on August 27, 1997. On that same date, the Honorable Anita B. Brody granted the Commission's motion for a temporary restraining order. She also granted a freeze of assets against the defendants as well as six relief defendants.

In addition to entering the preliminary injunction, Judge Dalzell continued the freeze of assets ordered by Judge Brody. Pursuant to the Order, he also appointed Robert F. Sanville, C.P.A., Sanville & Company, as trustee for the assets of TIGC, and required the defendants and relief defendants to repatriate all funds and assets held in off-shore bank accounts to Sanville. A trial date of November 20, 1997 has been scheduled.

The Commission's complaint alleges that, from at least August 1994 through the present, TIGC, Benson and O'Connor have engaged in a fraudulent scheme through which they have raised at least \$5 million, and possibly as much as \$9.7 million, from at least 4,200 public investors, including at least 58 investors residing in Philadelphia and the surrounding area. The complaint alleges that the defendants induced investors to purchase interests in TIGC's "Asset Enhancement Plan" by promising them rates of return ranging from 138 to 181 percent. These returns were portrayed as "guaranteed." Through various offering materials, TIGC, Benson and O'Connor claimed that they could generate these returns by pooling investor funds in TIGC bank accounts and investing them in so-called "Prime Bank" instruments or other unspecified investments.

At the preliminary injunction hearing, the Commission presented expert testimony of Professor James Byrne, who testified that the TIGC offering was fraudulent, and that the instruments and

investments described in the TIGC offering materials did not exist. The Commission also presented testimony of Staff Accountant Kevin B. de Lacy who testified that, rather than investing the proceeds as represented, TIGC, Benson and O'Connor diverted the money to various bank accounts, where some or all of it was misappropriated. Substantial sums were diverted to accounts under their control or under the control of the six relief defendants. Mr. de Lacy further testified that funds raised in the TIGC offering were used to pay existing investors or were diverted to off-shore bank accounts in St. Kitts, West Indies, Spain and the Principality of Monaco.

To date, the Commission has confirmed that more than \$3 million in assets has been frozen. [U.S. v. The Infinity Group Company, Geoffrey P. Benson and Geoffrey J. O'Connor, et al., USDC, ED PA, Civil Action No. 97-CV-5458] (LR-15477)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MUTUAL FUND VARIABLE ANNUITY TRUST, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Mutual Fund Variable Annuity Trust (Trust) and The Chase Manhattan Bank from the provisions of Sections 9(a), 13(a), 15(a) and 15(b) of the Act, and Rules 6e-2(b)(15) and 6e-3(T)(b)(15) thereunder. The order provides exemptions to the extent necessary to permit shares of the Trust to be sold to and held by separate accounts funding variable annuity and variable life insurance contracts issued by both affiliated and unaffiliated life insurance companies, and qualified pension and retirement plans outside the separate account context. VARIABLE ACCOUNT SIX

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 30 to request a hearing on an application filed by Variable Account Six (Applicant) of Anchor National Life Insurance Company for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that the Applicant has ceased to be an investment company. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Philadelphia Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-Phlx-97-23) to provide double-up/double-down automatic price improvement and manual price protection to customer orders under

certain circumstances. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of September 8. (Rel. 34-39000)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-97-26) filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange to list and Trade Regular and Long-Term Index Options and FLEX Options on the Dow Jones Industrial Average. (Rel. 34-39011)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-97-28) to list regular options, full and reduced value long-term index options, and FLEX options on the Dow Jones Utility Average. (Rel. 34-39013)
