CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

MACDONALD CASE AFFIRMED BY FIRST CIRCUIT

The Boston Regional Office announced that on January 11 the U.S. Court of Appeals for the First Circuit affirmed, in a per curiam opinion, the order of the U.S. District Court in Rhode Island ordering James E. MacDonald, Jr., a defendant in SEC v. MacDonald, 568 F. Supp. III (D.R.I., 1983), to disgorge \$18,037.50, plus interest,

obtained as a result of trading on inside information respecting the stock of Realty Income Trust. The order followed a trial on remand, which followed an earlier trial and two appeals (SEC v. MacDonald, 699 F. 2d 47 [1983]). The issue in the instant matter involved a determination as to when inside information became disseminated in the market place. The Court of Appeals affirmed that it was appropriate in making this determination to consider the volume and price at which the stock is traded a reasonable time following disclosure. (SEC v. James E. MacDonald, Jr., U.S. Court of Appeals for the First Circuit No. 83-1568). (LR-10265)

HUTTON TELEPHONE TRUST, FIRST TAX-FREE EXCHANGE SERIES AND SUBSEQUENT SERIES
