CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

FINAL JUDGMENT ENTERED AGAINST MANOHAR LAL MADAN

On January 14, in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York, Manohar Lal Madan consented to a final judgment in an insider trading action brought by the Commission against him and 13 other defendants. Without admitting or denying the allegations, Madan was ordered to disgorge \$25,000 in profits from the securities trading alleged in the complaint and enjoined from further violations of the antifraud and tender offer provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

The Commission alleged that from 1976 to 1982, Madan worked as a typist at Wachtell, Lipton, Rosen and Katz, a New York law firm, where he typed documents containing confidential information about impending takeovers involving Wachtell clients. According to the complaint, Madan improperly disclosed some of this information to other defendants who purchased the securities of takeover targets before their public announcement. The Commission further alleged that the defendants made profits of nearly \$2 million by trading in the securities of 26 companies on the basis of confidential information misappropriated from Wachtell. Madan had already entered pleas of guilty to criminal charges arising from the same facts alleged in the complaint and to perjury in his testimony during the Commission's private investigation. (SEC v. Manohar Lal Madan, et al., USDC SDNY, 83 Civ. 5053 [MEL], filed July 7, 1983). (LR-10991)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

CRIMINAL CONTEMPT PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST DONALD C. DECKER

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on January 16 the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan entered an Order to Show Cause Why Donald C. Decker Should Not Be Punished for Criminal Contempt (Order). Decker, of Oklahoma, had previously been enjoined in September 1976 [SEC v. International Mining and Petroleum Company; Donald C. Decker, EDMI, CA No. 671903] from violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws.

The Order was based on an application filed by the Commission which alleged that between March and August 1982, and in March 1984, Decker violated the 1976 injunction in the offer and sale of common stock of Equine America Corporation, an Arizona corporation. The Commission's application alleged that Decker sold unregistered Equine common stock without an available exemption from registration and in this offer and sale made misrepresentations of material facts and omitted material facts concerning the application and use of proceeds from the sale of the securities, the financial condition of Equine, and the future market price of Equine.

A hearing date of February 10 has been set in this matter. (U.S. ex rel. SEC v. Donald C. Decker, EDMI, So. Div. Misc. No. 85-1254). (LR-10989)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

JOHN HANCOCK VARIABLE LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued granting an exemption from the provisions of Section 17(a) of the Investment Company Act by John Hancock Variable Life Insurance Company (JHVLICO); Variable Life Stock Account of John Hancock Variable Life Insurance Company; Variable Life Bond Account of John Hancock Variable Life Insurance Company; Variable Life Money Market Account of John Hancock Variable Life Insurance Company; John Hancock Variable Series Fund I, Inc.; and John Hancock Mutual Life Insurance Company. This exemption will permit the reorganization of JHVLICO's separate accounts

from three management companies to a single unit investment trust issuing variable life insurance contracts funded by a single underlying management company of the series type. (Rel. IC-14913 - Jan. 27)

EQUITEC SIEBEL TOTAL RETURN FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 21 to request a hearing on an application filed by Equitec Siebel Total Return Fund, Inc., for an order exempting it from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c) and 22(d) and Rule 22c-1 to permit it to assess and, in certain cases, waive a contingent deferred sales charge on redemptions of its shares. RYLAND ACCEPTANCE CORPORATION FOUR; TWELVE STAR PARTNERS, LTD.

Orders have been issued on an application filed by Ryland Acceptance Corporation Four, subsidiary of Ryland Mortgage Company, and Twelve Star Partners, Ltd., a Florida limited partnership, exempting them from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-14915; IC-14917 - Jan. 27)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

VERMONT YANKEE NUCLEAR POWER CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 20 to request a hearing on a proposal by Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Corporation, subsidiary of New England Electric System and Northeast Utilities, to issue and sell short-term notes to banks to evidence its borrowings under lines of credit with those banks up to a maximum amount of \$16 million through August 31, 1987. GULF POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Gulf Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to issue and sell, prior to September 1, 1986, up to \$50 million aggregate principal amount of its first mortgage bonds with a maturity of not less than five nor more than 30 years. CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 20 to request a hearing on a proposal by Consolidated Natural Gas Company, a registered holding company, to amend its certificate of incorporation and issue common stock in connection with a two-for-one stock split. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
