ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

SEATTLE BROKER BARRED

The Commission accepted an offer of settlement from Andrew L. Evans providing for the simultaneous institution of proceedings, entry of findings and imposition of an administrative sanction against him. The proceedings were based on an admitted finding that during September 1985 Evans had pleaded guilty to and had been convicted of bank fraud charges involving false documents and misapplication of bank funds. The Commission barred Evans from association with any broker or dealer, investment adviser, investment company, municipal securities broker or municipal securities dealer, with the proviso that after the later of the satisfaction completion of the five year probation term to which he was sentenced in connection with his conviction, or June 1, 1991, he may apply to the appropriate regulatory authority to seek readmission to the securities industry. MUTUAL BENEFIT FUNDING, INC.

An order has been issued exempting Mutual Benefit Life Insurance Company from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-15092 - May 8)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 27 to request a hearing on a proposal by Consolidated Natural Gas Company, a registered holding company, to purchase not more than 13,333 shares of ACE Limited, at a price of \$150 per share, for a total investment not exceeding \$2 million. TRANS WORLD AIRLINES, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 20 to request a hearing on an application by Trans World Airlines, Inc., a Delaware corporation, under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
