CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED AGAINST DENNIS LEVINE, OTHERS

The Commission filed a civil injunctive action on May 12 against Dennis Levine, also known as Mr. Diamond (Levine), two Panamanian corporations created by Levine, International Gold, Inc. and Diamond Holdings, S.A. and Bernhard Meier, alleging that they, through an insider trading scheme, violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. At the same time, the Commission sought and obtained from the District Court a Temporary Restraining Order, an Order to Show Cause Why a Preliminary Injunction Should Not be Entered, an Order Freezing Defendants' Assets, an Order for an Accounting, an Order for Substituted Service, an Order for Expedited Discovery and an Order Preventing Document Alteration or Destruction.

The Commission's complaint and supporting papers allege that for more than five years, Levine, a Managing Director of Drexel Burnham Lambert, Inc., secretly purchased and sold securities and reaped over \$12.6 million in illicit profits as the result of his scheme to profit from the systematic betrayal of client confidences. Meier, Levine's broker, also profited from this betrayal.

The District Court ordered that a Hearing on the Commission's Preliminary Injunction request be held on May 22. (SEC v. Dennis Levine, a/k/a Mr. Diamond, et al., USDC SDNY, Civil Action No. 86 Civ. 3726 [RO]). (LR-11095)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITIES CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing General Public Utilities Corporation (GPU), a registered holding company, to acquire the common stock of a nonaffiliated insurance company for \$5,197,000. (Rel. 35-24089 - May 7)

An order has also been issued authorizing GPU to make capital contributions to its subsidiary, Metropolitan Edison Company, in an aggregate amount not exceeding \$50 million. (Rel. 35-24091 - May 7)

CNG PRODUCING COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued approving the terms and conditions of letters of credit obtained by CNG Producing Company, subsidiary of Consolidated Natural Gas Company, in amounts up to \$1,382,986.19. (Rel. 35-24090 - May 7)

An order has also been issued granting the application of the American Stock Exchange to strike the common stock, par value \$.80, of RATLIFF DRILLING EXPLORATION COMPANY from listing and registration thereon. (Rel. 34-23216)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Securities Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change which became effective upon filing under Section 19(b)(3)(A). The rule change (SR-NSCC-86-6) modifies NSCC's fee structure to establish a fee for the processing of an adjustment to a customer's account number in the ACAT system. (Rel. 34-23209)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Pacific Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-PSE-86-4) to specify the date and time of suspension of trading in dually-traded securities that have been suspended by the primary market due to a merger or buyout. (Rel. 34-23214)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Depository Trust Company filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-DTC-86-4) that would modify, among other things, its procedures for crediting cash dividend and interest payments, charge-backs of dividend and interest payments, dividend and interest refunds and passing through fund usage charges on bearer municipal bond interest payments. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of May 12. (Rel. 34-23215)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

ACF INDUSTRIES, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 30 to request a hearing on an application by ACF Industries, Inc. under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act. The application declares that the trusteeship of Fleet National Bank under two existing indentures is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify the Bank from acting as trustee. The Bank is currently acting as trustee under the following indentures dated: (1) December 15, 1984, involving the issuance of sinking fund debentures; and (2) February 28, 1986, involving the issuance of sinking fund notes (for which, on April 29, 1986, a registration statement on Form S-2 was filed, File No. 33-5253). Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
