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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST ROBERT M. WILKIS

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Robert M. Wilkis under Section 15(b)(6) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Simultaneous with the institution of those proceedings, Wilkis submitted an offer of settlement for the purpose of disposing of the issues raised by these proceedings.

In accepting Wilkis' Offer of Settlement, the Commission found that Wilkis had been permanently enjoined by the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York from future violations of the antifraud provisions [Sections 10(b) and 14(e) of the Exchange Act] and rules and regulations thereunder. Based upon these findings, the Commission ordered that Wilkis be barred from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-23385) [see LR-11146]

### PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST IRA B. SOKOLOW

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Ira B. Sokolow under Section 15(b)(6) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Simultaneous with the institution of those proceedings, Sokolow submitted an offer of settlement for the purpose of disposing of the issues raised by these proceedings.

In accepting Sokolow's Offer of Settlement, the Commission found that Sokolow had been permanently enjoined by the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York from future violations of the antifraud provisions [Sections 10(b) and 14(e) of the Exchange Act] and rules and regulations thereunder. Based upon these findings, the Commission ordered that Sokolow be barred from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-23386) [see LR-11146]

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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### DEFAULT JUDGMENT ENTERED AGAINST BERNHARD MEIER

The Commission announced that on July 1 a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction by Default was entered against Bernhard Meier, enjoining him from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

The May 12 complaint alleged that Meier was the Bahamian banker for Dennis B. Levine, who was alleged to have secretly traded in the securities of 54 companies while in possession of material nonpublic information. The complaint also alleged that Meier, through a Bahamian bank account, traded in the securities of 18 of these companies after receiving material nonpublic information from Levine, thereby obtaining \$184,181 in illegal profits. Levine has previously settled a Commission enforcement action. [See Lit. Releases 11095 and 11117, dated May 13 and June 6, 1986].

The Commission previously sought and obtained a temporary restraining order on May 12 and a preliminary injunction on May 22 against Meier, enjoining him from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the Exchange Act and the rules and regulations thereunder. (SEC v. Dennis Levine, a/k/a Mr. Diamond, et al., USDC SDNY, Civil Action No. 86 Civ. 3726, RO). (LR-11144)

## CIVIL INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED AGAINST ROBERT M. WILKIS

The Commission filed a civil injunctive action on July 1 against Robert M. Wilkis and two foreign corporations controlled by him, Rupearl Ltd. and Middleside Ltd., alleging that they violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 through an insider trading scheme. The complaint alleges that for more than five years, Wilkis, an investment banker formerly employed at Lazard Freres & Co. and E.F. Hutton & Co., secretly purchased and sold securities while in possession of material nonpublic information. The Complaint further alleges that Wilkis and Dennis B. Levine, another investment banker, shared information obtained by virtue of their employment and used this information to trade illegally in securities. Levine has previously settled a Commission enforcement action. [See Lit. Releases 11095 and 11117, dated May 13 and June 6, 1986].

Without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations, the defendants consented to a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Relief requiring them, among other things, to disgorge profits of approximately \$2.5 million derived from the alleged trading violations and to disgorge additional assets worth approximately \$800,000. (SEC v. Robert M. Wilkis, et al., USDC SDNY, Civil Action 86 Civ. 5182). (LR-11145)

## CIVIL INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED IRA B. SOKOLOW

The Commission filed a civil injunctive action on July 1 against Ira B. Sokolow, alleging that he violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The complaint alleges that over a two-year period, Sokolow, an investment banker employed at all relevant times at Lehman Brothers Kuhn Loeb Incorporated and its successor Shearson/Lehman American Express, in more than a dozen instances provided material nonpublic information he acquired by virtue of his employment to Dennis B. Levine, who used the information to trade illegally in securities. Levine paid Sokolow compensation of approximately \$120,000 in cash for providing the information. Levine has previously settled a Commission enforcement action. [See Lit. Releases 11095 and 11117, dated May 13 and June 6, 1986].

Without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations, Sokolow consented to a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Relief requiring him among other things, to disgorge approximately \$210,000 in cash. (For further information see (SEC v. Ira B. Sokolow, USDC SDNY, Civil Action No. 86 Civ. 5193). (LR-11146)

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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### BOETTCHER & COMPANY, INC.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Boettcher & Company, Inc. exempting certain transactions from the provisions of Section 30(f) of the Investment Company Act to the extent that it incorporates the provisions of Section 16 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. (Rel. IC-15173 - June 27)

### MITSUBISHI BANK (PANAMA) S.A.

An order has been issued exempting Mitsubishi Bank (Panama) S.A. from all provisions of the Investment Company Act so it may make public offerings of U.S. dollar denominated certificates of deposit and other debt securities in the United States. (Rel. IC-15174 - June 27)

### INTERNATIONAL INVESTORS INCORPORATED

An order has been issued approving certain offers of exchange on a basis other than relative net asset value by International Investors Incorporated, Van Eck Funds and Van Eck Securities Corporation. (Rel. IC-15175 - June 27)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
