### ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

---

#### ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS AGAINST ALAN LIBMAN

The Commission announced that public administrative proceedings were instituted and settled against Alan D. Libman. The proceedings arose out of the operations of Cambridge Capital Corporation, formerly a broker-dealer registered with the Commission. At relevant times, Libman was employed in Cambridge Capital's Los Angeles office. Without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations, Libman consented to an Order which found that he participated in the offer and sale of unregistered securities. In connection with such sales, Libman was found to have made false and misleading statements and/or failed to disclose material facts to investors concerning, among other things, the use of proceeds raised in the offerings, the risks and potential profits associated with the investments, and the financial condition and business prospects of the companies. Libman was barred from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer in any capacity. (Rel. 34-33580)

#### ROBERT GERMANI PERMANENTLY BARRED

The Commission issued Findings and an Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions (Order) against Robert Germani (Germani), a New York resident. Germani consented to the Order Instituting Proceedings and submitted an Offer of Settlement in which he consented to a revocation of his registration with the Commission as an investment adviser. Germani also consented to the imposition of a permanent bar from association in any capacity with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company.

The basis for the foregoing sanctions is Germani's admission that he was twice convicted of violating provisions of the federal mail and wire fraud statutes and, in 1992, was incarcerated for violating the terms of his parole pursuant to the second such conviction. (Rel. IA-1402)

#### INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

---

##### THE SEVEN SEAS SERIES FUND, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 7 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Seven Seas Series Fund, et al. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act conditionally exempting applicants from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 18(f), 18(g), 18(i), 22(c), and 22(d), of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The order would permit applicants to offer an unlimited number of classes of shares representing interest in the same portfolio of securities, to assess a contingent deferred sales load (CDSL) on certain redemptions of shares, and to waive the CDSL in certain instances. #### HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

##### CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION, ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing Central and South West Corporation (CSW), a registered holding company, and its nonutility subsidiaries, CSW Energy, Inc. (Energy), CSW Development-I, Inc. (Energy Sub), ARK/CSW Development Partnership, Orange Cogeneration Limited Partnership (Project Venture), Orange Cogeneration Limited G.P., Inc., and CSW Orange, Inc. to finance the construction and operation of an approximately \$140 million, 103 megawatt qualifying cogeneration facility (Project) located in or near Bartow, Florida. Finally, CSW and Energy propose to give an indemnity of title for the Project site to the title company issuing the title insurance policy on the Project site. (Rel. 35-25988)

##### REQUEST FOR TEMPORARY REGISTRATION

The Depository Trust Company filed a proposed rule change (SR-DTC-94-02) that would allow participants to pledge government securities to replace cash deposits to cover Next-Day Funds Settlement short positions.
