AUTHORIZATION OF PUBLICATION OF REGULATORY FLEXIBILITY AGENDA

The Commission has authorized the publication of its April 1994 Regulatory Flexibility Act Agenda. The agenda is a general announcement to the public intended to provide advance notice of rulemaking actions. The agenda, which will not be available to the public until its publication, has been submitted by the Commission to the Regulatory Information Service Center for inclusion in the Unified Agenda of Federal Regulations, which is scheduled for publication in the Federal Register in April 1994. ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

NEW YORK STOCK EXCHANGE DISCIPLINARY ACTION AGAINST MORRIS KURZ SET ASIDE IN PART AND REMANDED FOR RECONSIDERATION OF SANCTIONS

The Commission has set aside in part and sustained in part NYSE disciplinary action against Morris E. Kurz, a floor broker for a member corporation. The NYSE action was based on Kurz's accepting \$10,000 in floor commissions for services to third parties without forwarding the funds to his employer. The Exchange found that this conduct violated both his employment contract with a member firm, making it inconsistent with just and equitable principles of trade, and Exchange Rule 301.36(3) -- receiving floor commissions not for the account of the employing member organization. Kurz was censured and suspended for two years.

The Commission set aside the finding that Kurz's conduct violated his employment contract and just and equitable principles of trade since, under state law, his employer's prior breach relieved him of his obligations under the contract. The Commission remanded the proceedings to the Exchange for consideration in the first instance of appropriate sanctions for violation of NYSE Rule 301.36(3). (Rel. 34-33764)

SETTLEMENT REACHED WITH STRATTON OAKMONT, INC., JORDAN BELFORT, KENNETH GREENE AND DANIEL PORUSH

The Commission accepted the offers of settlement of Stratton Oakmont, Inc., Jordan Belfort, Kenneth Greene and Daniel Porush. Stratton will pay disgorgement of \$1,537,146 plus prejudgment interest of \$518,622, to be used to compensate Stratton customers, and civil penalties of \$500,000. Further, Stratton consented to an Order that censures Stratton and orders it to comply with certain remedial undertakings. Belfort will be permanently enjoined from violations of the antifraud provisions and required to pay a civil penalty of \$100,000. Further, Belfort consented to an Order that bars him from association with certain commission regulated entities. Greene will be permanently enjoined from violations of the antifraud provisions and required to pay a civil penalty of \$100,000. Further, Greene consented to an Order that bars him from association with certain commission regulated entities with a right to reapply after five years. Porush consented to an Order that suspends him from association in a supervisory capacity with certain commission regulated entities for a period of 12 months and orders him to pay a penalty of \$100,000.

The complaint alleged that the defendants engaged in fraudulent sales practices in the operation of a boiler-room broker-dealer and manipulated the market price of the securities of Nova Capital, Inc. (SEC v. Stratton Oakmont, Inc., et al., Civil Action No. 92-1993, JES). (Rel. 34-33778)

CIVIL ACTION AGAINST VISION COMMUNICATIONS, INC., WILLIAM CLEMENS, JR., MICHAEL IMBESI AND WILKES-BARRE-SCRANTON, L.C.

The Commission filed a complaint in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia against Vision Communications, Inc. (VCI), William L. Clemens, Jr., Michael Imbesi and Wilkes-Barre-Scranton, L.C. (WBS), a limited liability company which is purportedly developing a wireless cable television system in the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton, Pennsylvania area. The complaint alleges violations of the antifraud, securities registration and broker-dealer registration provisions of the federal securities laws and seeks a temporary restraining order and other emergency relief, orders for preliminary and permanent injunctions, and civil penalties. The complaint alleges that, from early 1994 through the present, defendants have raised approximately \$1.25 million from investors nationwide from sales of "membership units" in WBS. The complaint alleges that defendants knowingly or recklessly made false and misleading statements to investors concerning WBS and its business prospects.

The Court took the Commission's Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order under advisement. Pending determination of the Commission's Motion, the Court issued an order freezing all investor funds under the defendants' control, subject to certain conditions; providing that any new funds raised from investors be placed in an escrow account; requiring an accounting; and providing for expedited discovery.

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CALIFORNIA TAX-FREE MONEY TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 18 to request a hearing on an application filed by California Tax-Free Money Trust for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ENTERGY CORPORATION, ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Entergy Corporation (Entergy), a registered holding company, and its wholly owned public-utility subsidiary company, Gulf States Utilities Company (Gulf States), for Gulf States to engage in short-term borrowings up to \$125 million through November 30, 1994, by borrowing from the Entergy system money pool; issuing short-term notes to banks; and/or issuing and selling commercial paper to commercial dealers (collectively, Short-Term Borrowings). Jurisdiction is reserved over additional Short-Term Borrowings up to \$330 million. (Rel. 35-26010)

BARRY'S JEWELERS, INC.

The Commission has issued an order under Section 304(d) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 on an application filed by Barry's Jewelers, Inc. with respect to an indenture (Indenture) between the Company and First Trust National Association, as trustee, conditionally exempting specified provisions of the Indenture from the requirements of Section 314(d) of the Act.
