ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

FINAL JUDGMENT OF PERMANENT INJUNCTIVE AND OTHER EQUITABLE RELIEF ENTERED AGAINST ROSS FRANKEL

The Commission announced that on May 18 the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunctive and Other Equitable Relief, by consent, against Ross 8. Frankel (Frankel), a former corporate vice-president in the Domestic Arbitrage Department at Drexel Burnham Lambert, Inc., whom the Commission charged with trading in the securities of American Brands, Inc. (American Brands) while in possession of material, nonpublic information concerning a considered acquisition of American Brands by BAT Industries, Inc.

The Final Judgment, which was signed by the Honorable Milton Pollack, Senior U.S. District Court Judge, permanently enjoins Frankel from future violations of Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5. In addition, the Final Judgment orders Frankel to disgorge \$8,714, representing his unlawful trading profits, prejudgment interest, and a \$8,714 penalty under the Insider Trading Sanctions Act of 1984. The settlement was made without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint, which was filed on March 8, 1991 (LR-12800). [SEC v. Victor Teicher, Ross S. INSIDER TRADING COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST PHILIP SHERIDAN AND GILBERT CARPENTER

The Commission announced the filing of a civil injunctive action on June 2 against Philip P. Sheridan and Gilbert D. Carpenter alleging that in May 1992, Sheridan and Carpenter engaged in illegal insider trading by misappropriating material nonpublic information from their employer, LDDS Communications, Inc., concerning LDDS's plans to merge with Advanced Telecommunications Corp. and using that information in their purchases of Advanced Telecommunications stock. Sheridan realized trading profits of more than \$47,000, and Carpenter realized trading profits of more than \$1,300. Without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint, both of the defendants consented to the relief sought by the Commission, including a permanent injunction and disgorgement of their trading profits, prejudgment interest and penalties. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION, ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Central and South West Corporation (CSW), a registered holding company, and its nonutility subsidiary companies, CSW Energy, Inc., CSW Development-I, Inc. (Energy Sub), Polk Power Partners, L.P., Polk Power GP, Inc. (JV Sub), ARK/CSW Development Partnership (Joint Venture), CSW Mulberry, Inc. (CSW Mulberry), and two proposed subsidiary companies, CSW Mulberry II, Inc. (Mulberry LP Sub) and Polk Power GP II, Inc. (Mulberry GP Sub). The order authorizes Energy Sub and Joint Venture to acquire all of the common stock Mulberry LP Sub and Mulberry GP Sub, respectively, and to assign their respective interests in CSW Mulberry and JV Sub to Mulberry LP Sub and Mulberry GP Sub, respectively. Thereafter, Mulberry LP Sub and Mulberry GP Sub will be entitled to receive the equity contributions, advances and loans as previously authorized in connection with the construction and financing of a cogeneration project located in Polk County, Florida. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the <u>Government Securities Clearing Corporation</u> (SR-GSCC-94-2) that will permit GSCC to offer comparison and netting services for non-member trades. Publication of the approval order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 6. (Rel. 34-34134)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-93-17) to amend Exchange Rule 96 to permit NYSE Floor professionals who have a listed option position in a stock to initiate an on-Floor proprietary trade in that stock. (Rel. 34-34135)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-89-17) to allow Floor Governors to change the two point price parameter in Rule 79A.30 for higher priced securities and to permit specialists to participate in certain trades that elect stop orders without guaranteeing the price of the elected stop orders or obtaining floor official approval. (Rel. 34-34136)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-93-44) filed by the <u>Chicago Board Options Exchange</u> which allows the CBOE to issue a Regulatory Circular relating to certain floor brokerage practices. Publication of the approval order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 6. (Rel. 34-34138)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>Chicago Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-MSE-93-9) to amend its Arbitration rules (Exchange Rules 23 and 24 of Article VIII). Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 6. (Rel. 34-34141)

The <u>Chicago Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-CHX-93-31) relating to short sales, summary actions by the President, a formal standard of review for appeals, limitation of liability, and payment of Exchange's legal expenses in certain circumstances. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 6. (Rel. 34-34142)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change submitted by the <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> (SR-NASD-94-26) to increase the subscriber charge for the recently expanded last sale information. (Rel. 34-34143)

CORRECTION

In the June 1 issue of the Digest it was inadvertently reported that proposed rule changes (SR-Phlx-94-01; Rel. 34-34130 and SR-CBOE-93-55; Rel. 34-34132) were approved by the Commission. The proposed rule changes were filed with the Commission but have not been approved.
